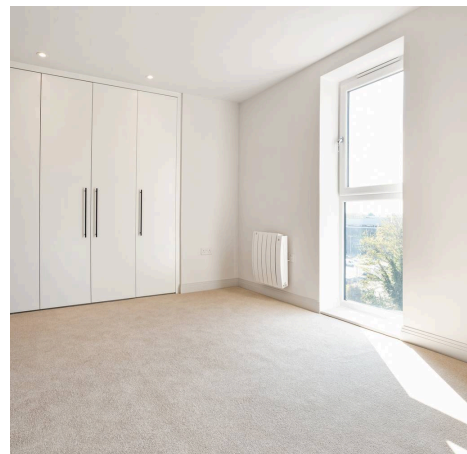

The kitchen is fitted with an attractive range of units and integrated appliances.

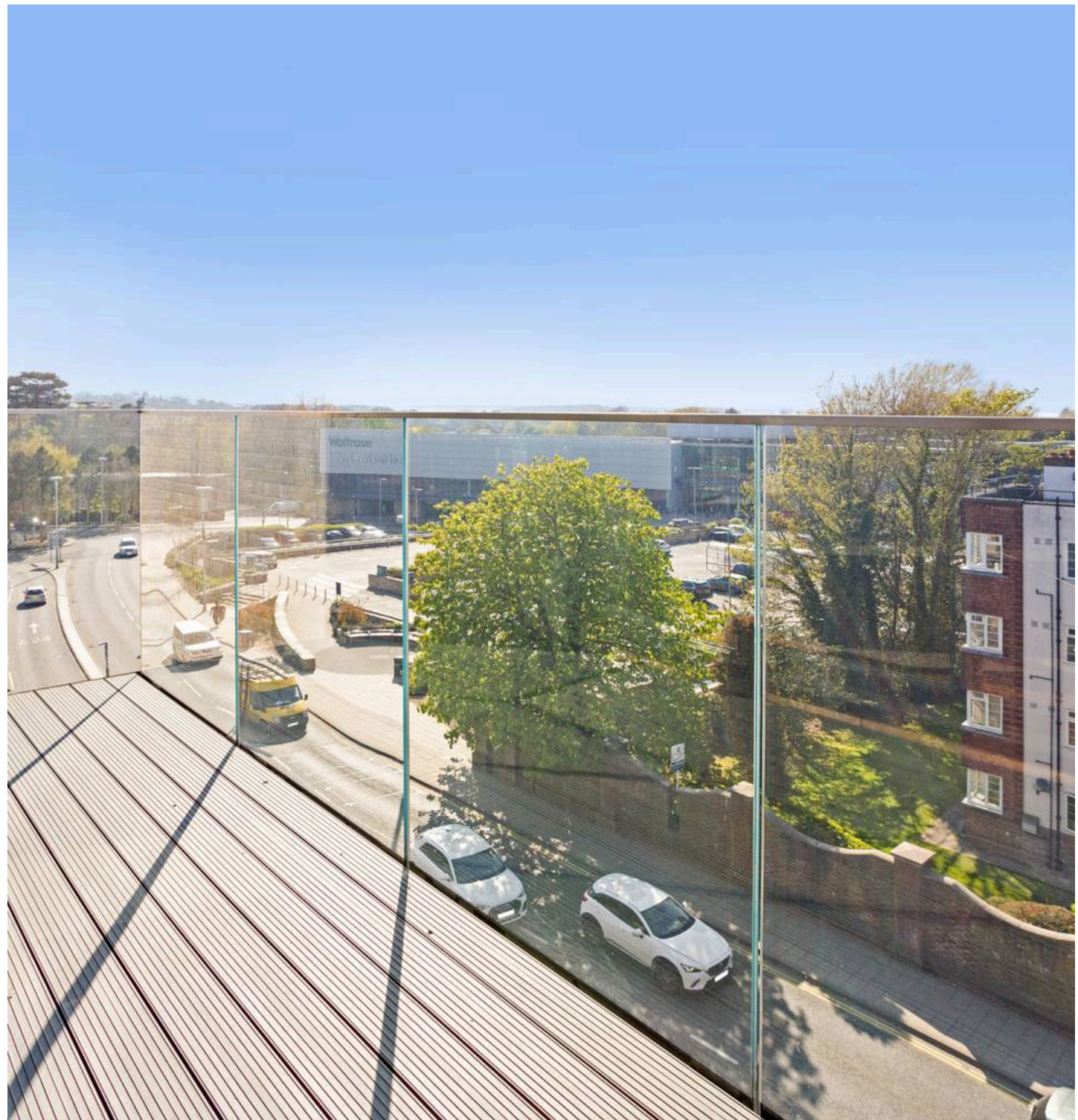

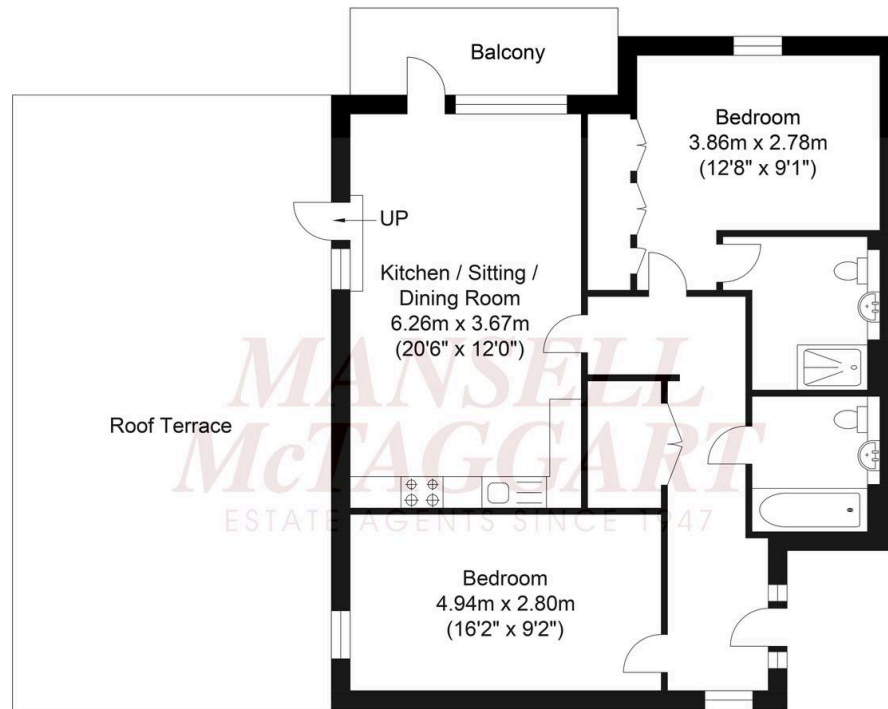
