The Property

This great home is offered for sale as a 25% share, perfect as an affordable home.

The property opens into a hallway with space for hanging coats and storing shoes plus a downstairs W.C. The sitting room is spacious with an electric fire providing a cosy feel and a focal point to the room. The sitting room leads through to the dining kitchen which has space for a 6 person dining table and chairs with French doors out to the garden, ideal for entertaining. The kitchen itself comprises of a range of wall and base units with a work surface over having a matching upstanding and a single sink with a draining board. There are spaces for a washing machine, fridge freezer and a freestanding electric cooker with an extractor hood over.

The first floor landing has a loft hatch and a store cupboard over the stairs. There are two double bedrooms with bedroom one to the rear and bedroom two to the front, bedroom three is a good single bedroom too and the house bathroom comprises of a panelled bath with a shower over and screen, a pedestal mounted washbasin and a push flush W.C.

Outside

There is an attractive lawned frontage with a pea gravel shrubbery and a tarmac driveway leads down the side providing off street parking with gated access to the rear garden. The rear garden is all enclosed and private with a paved seating area off the dining kitchen overlooking a lawned garden with a shrub border and a garden shed for storage all within fenced and hedged boundaries.

Location

Bedale is a market town and civil parish in the district of Hambleton, North Yorkshire. Listed in the Domesday Book as part of Catterick wapentake, markets have been held in the town since 1251 and the regular Tuesday market still takes place today. The town has a range of schooling opportunities for children up to the age of 16 years and also boasts a leisure centre with a swimming pool and gym, a football club, golf club and being the gateway to the Yorkshire Dales, there are plenty of scenic walks and country pursuits close by too. Bedale has excellent road links including the new bypass, and Junction 51 of the A1M provides access to the national motorway network. Other transport links close by are the main line railway station in Northallerton, Durham Tees Valley and Leeds Bradford airports are both within an hour's drive away.

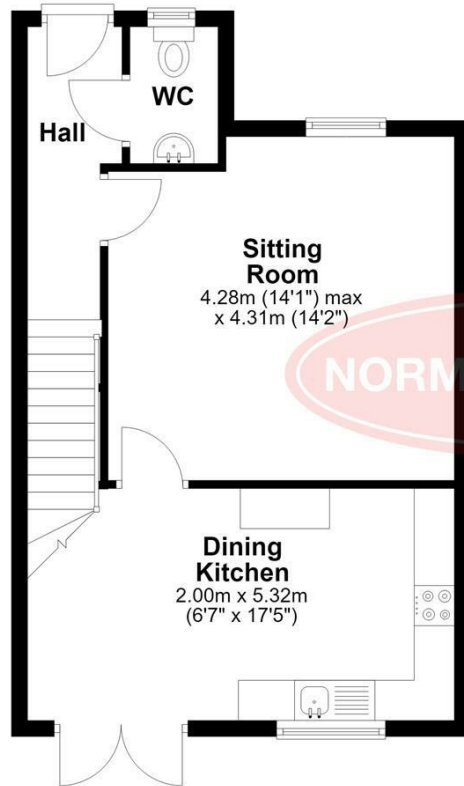

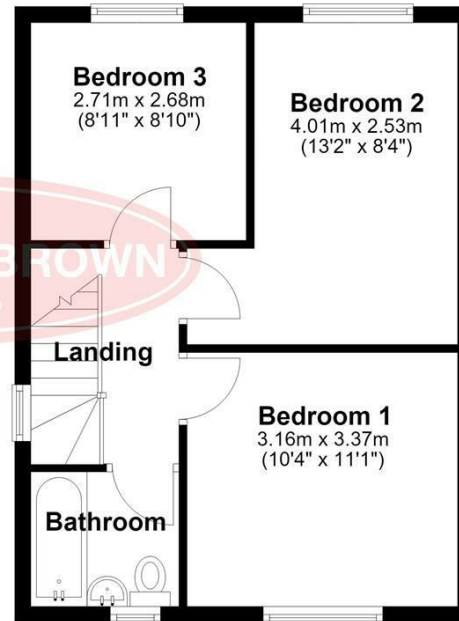
Ground Floor
