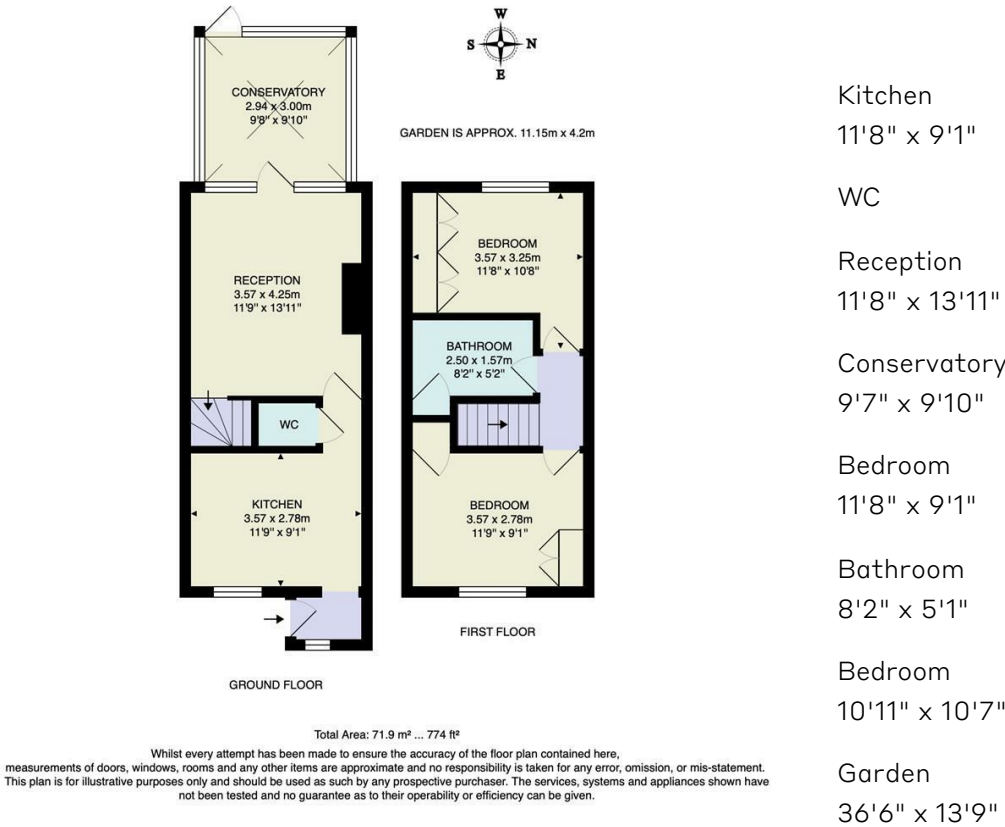






IF YOU LIVED HERE...

You'd step into a generous kitchen at the front of the house, fitted in a soft sage green with sleek cabinetry, integrated appliances and warm patterned flooring underfoot. Just beyond the entrance hall, there's a handy ground floor WC tucked beneath the stairs, while the main reception sits at the back of the house, giving the living space a quieter, more settled feel.

The reception room is bright and comfortable, with pale walls, timber flooring and a contemporary fireplace creating a calm focal point. Glazed doors lead straight into the conservatory, which works well as a dining area and brings in an extra sense of light and openness. From here, you have direct access to the rear garden, which is long, enclosed and leafy, with paved sections and plenty of planting softening the edges.

Upstairs, both bedrooms are well sized doubles, each finished in a clean, understated style. One is currently arranged as a bedroom, while the other has been set up as a bedroom and

study space, showing the flexibility on offer. The bathroom is smartly finished, with a curved bath, a separate shower above, pale tiling and a wood fronted vanity unit that adds a bit of warmth to the room.

- South Woodford Underground Station is within walking distance, with Central line services putting Liverpool Street and the West End within easy reach.
- George Lane has plenty for day to day life, from supermarkets and cafés to restaurants, bars and the local Odeon cinema.
- Epping Forest is close by for weekend walks, fresh air and a welcome change of pace from the high street.
