The accommodation briefly comprises of a spacious lounge, a fitted kitchen with access to a bright conservatory overlooking the rear garden.

To the first floor are two generously sized double bedrooms and a family bathroom.

Spacious second bedroom with double glazed window onto rear elevation

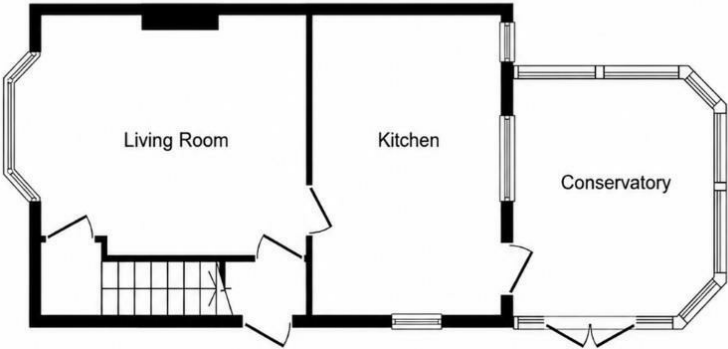
Bathroom

Family bathroom with airing cupboard and double glazed frosted window onto rear elevation

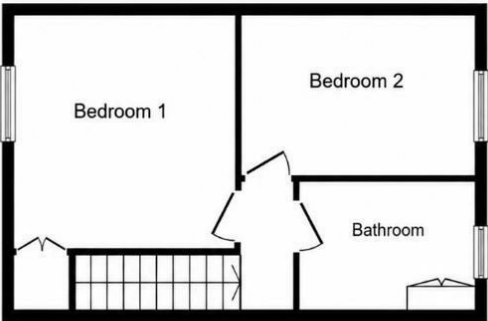
Garden

Floor Plan

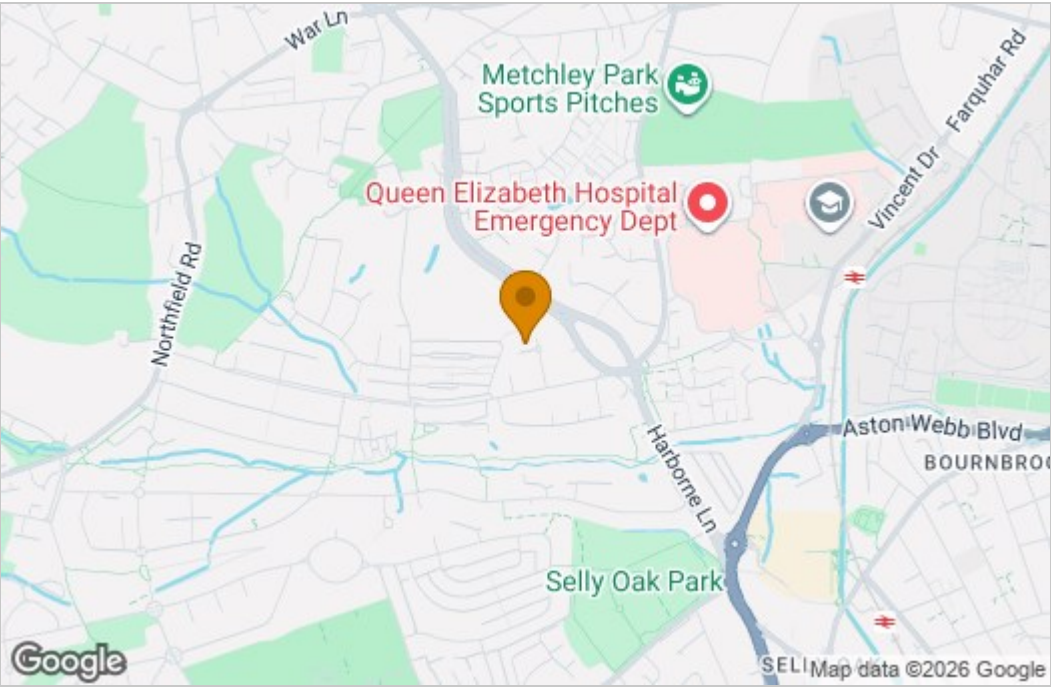


Ground Floor

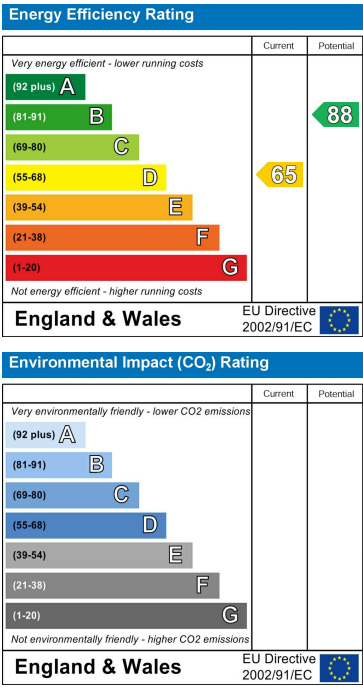


First Floor
