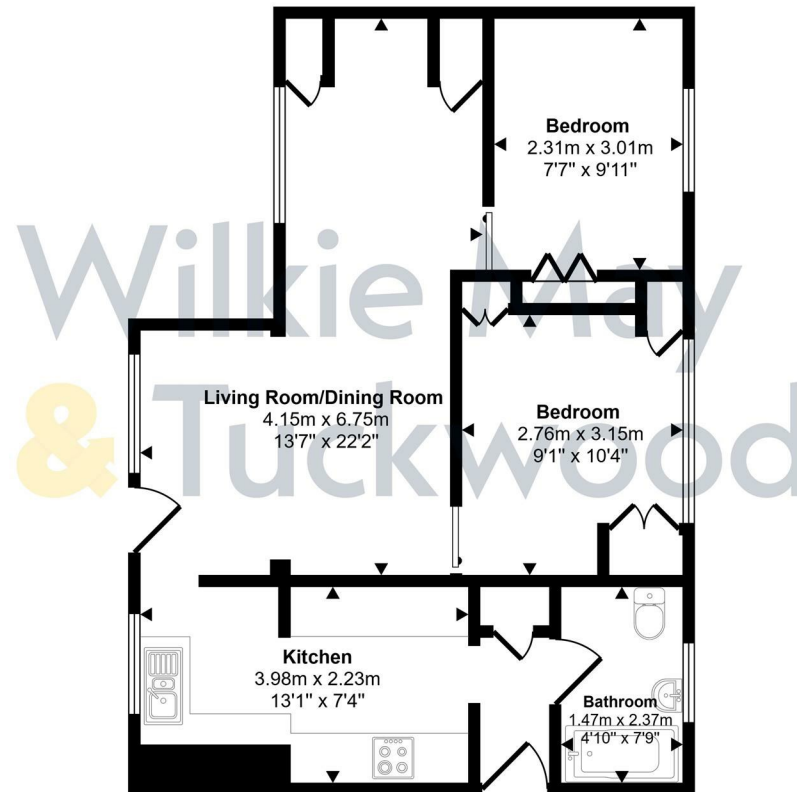

The accommodation in brief comprises; Part glazed uPVC door into Entrance Hall; with hatch to roof space, built in cupboard. Bathroom; with aspect to front; comprising a white suite with panelled bath, tiled surround, electric Mira shower over, low-level WC, wash basin with vanity unit under. Kitchen; with aspect to rear comprising a range of white cupboards and drawers under a solid oak worktop and granite affect squared edged worktop with inset sink and drainer, mixer tap over, tiled splashback, four ring electric hob with extractor over, space for under counter fridge, sliding door into L shaped Living Room/Dining Room; aspect to rear, part panelled walls, storage cupboard, boiler cupboard housing ATag Combi boiler for central heating and hot water. Bedroom One; with aspect to front and built-in wardrobe, hatch to principal roof space. Bedroom Two; aspect to front with built-in wardrobes.

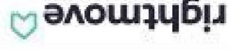
