Porch

Accessed off the driveway, UPVC construction with door into hallway.

Entrance Hall

Stairs to first floor with open storage under. Doors leading off.

Living/Dining Room

Spacious and bright room with window to front aspect, feature fireplace with modern electric fire, door to kitchen and double doors to the conservatory.

Conservatory

UPVC construction with door out to rear garden.

Kitchen

There is a range of storage cupboards with rolled edge work surfaces, built in electric oven, four ring gas hob, tiled flooring, window to the rear and door leading into utility room.

Utility Room

Further base and eye level storage, single drainer, stainless steel sink unit, plumbing and space for washing machine and space for further appliance, tiled flooring, window to rear and door to rear garden.

First Floor Landing

Access to loft space, airing cupboard with slatted shelving and doors leading off to bedrooms.

Bedroom One

Built in storage cupboard housing the boiler plus clothes hanging space and window to front aspect.

Bedroom Two

Window to the rear aspect overlooking the garden.

Bathroom

White suite comprising bath with shower attachment over, WC and wash basin plus frosted window to rear aspect.

To the front of the property is a gravelled driveway with parking for 3/4 vehicles. The rear garden is a generous size and enjoys a raised paved patio area ideal for al fresco dining, an expanse of lawn and is all enclosed by fencing.

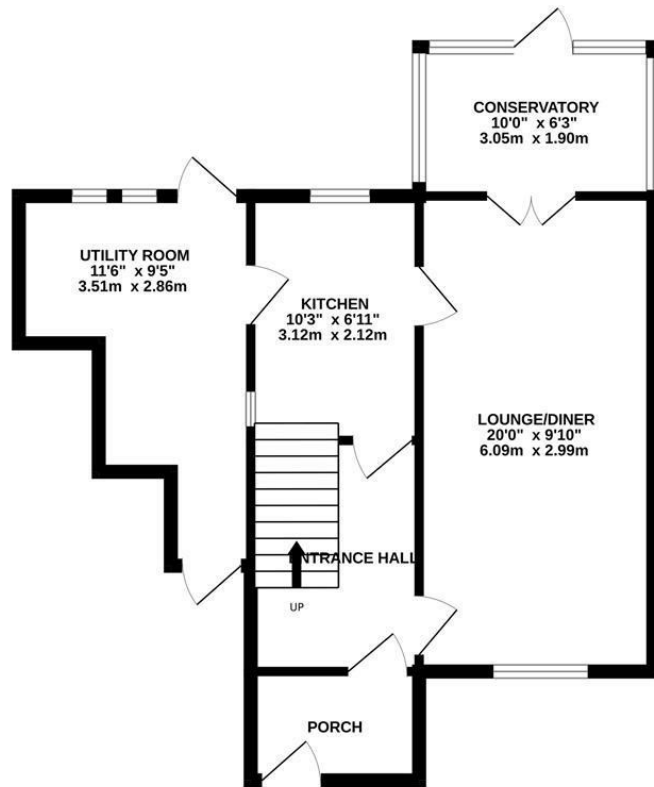

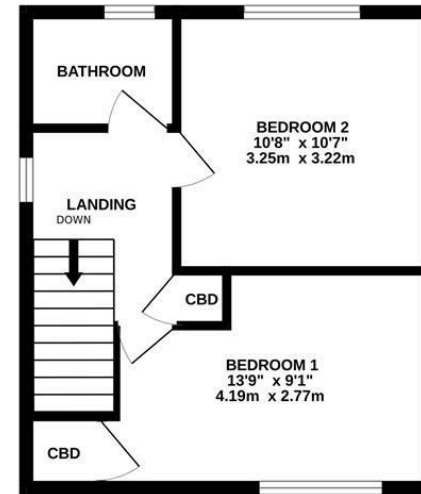




GROUND FLOOR
