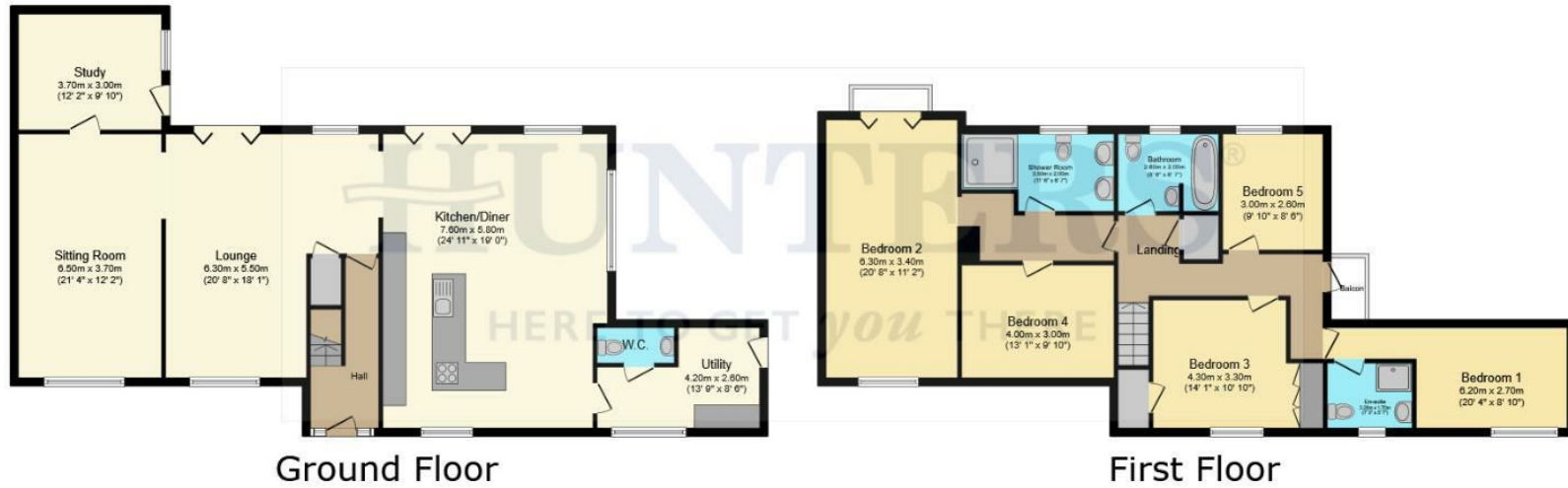
DIRECTION
