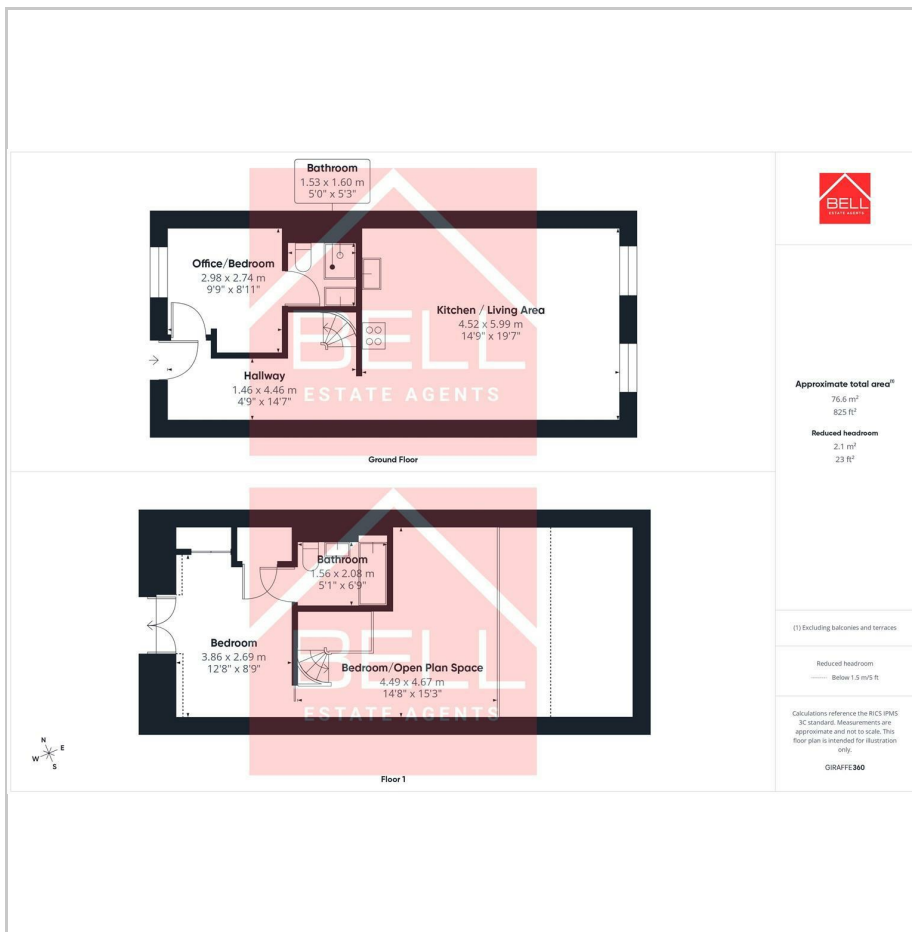

Occupying a superb position within the landmark Pandongate House development, the apartment combines contemporary finishes with warehouse-inspired design. The spacious open-plan kitchen and living area forms the heart of the home, creating an immediate sense of space and light through its impressive vaulted ceiling and mezzanine layout. Large windows and high ceilings enhance the bright and airy feel, whilst the modern décor creates a stylish and welcoming environment.

The sleek fitted kitchen features contemporary grey cabinetry, integrated appliances and generous worktop space, making it ideal for both everyday living and entertaining. The adjoining living and dining area offers excellent proportions and flexibility for modern lifestyles.
