The white sands of Peninver Beach with its stunning views are easily accessible as are the nearby forestry walks.

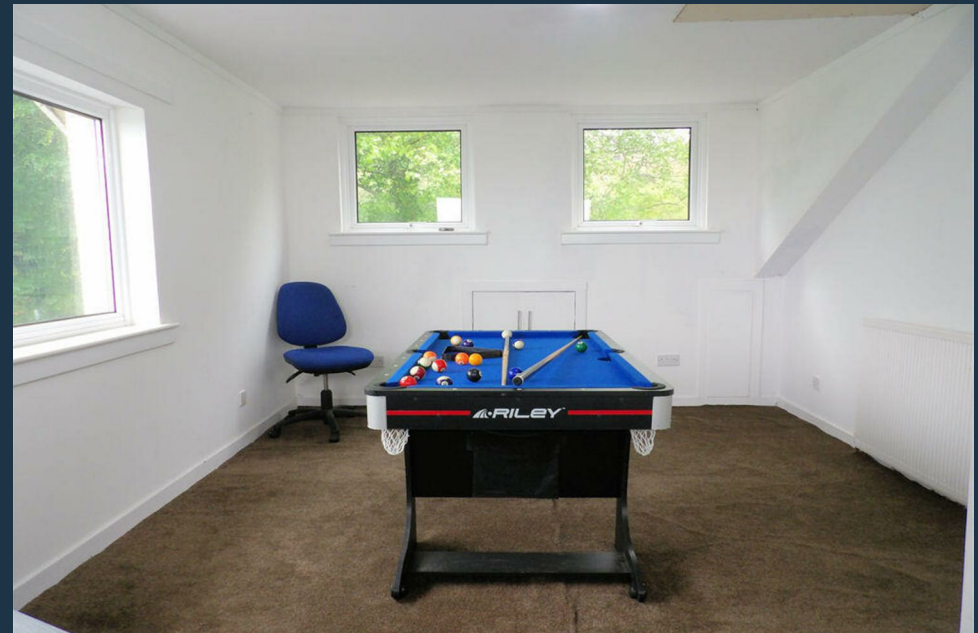

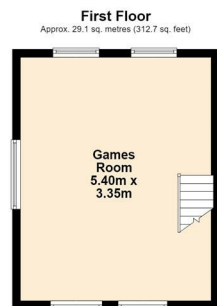
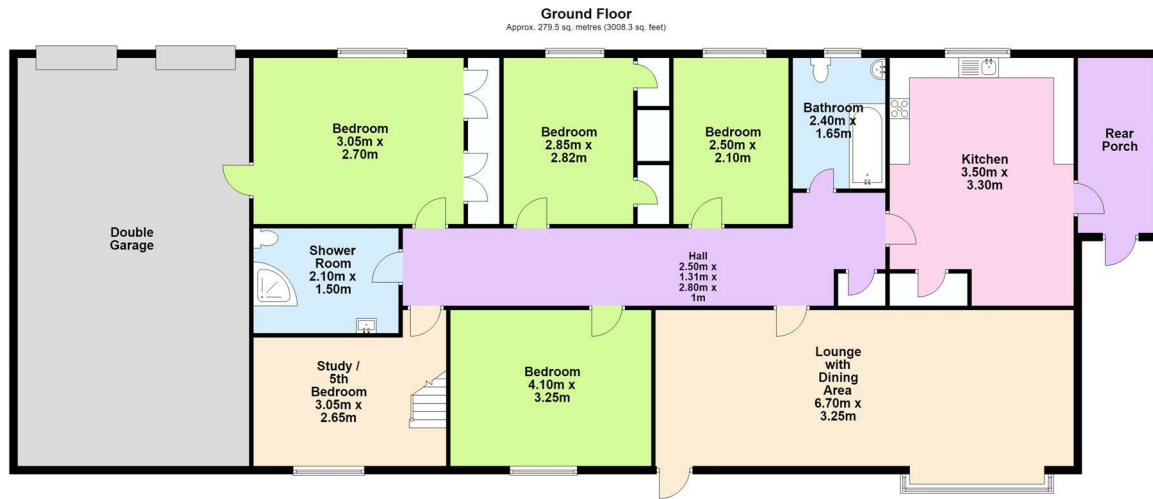
