The ground floor is centred around a generously proportioned sitting room, an impressive light-filled space with French doors opening directly onto the rear garden, creating an excellent connection between indoor and outdoor living. A well-appointed kitchen sits to the front of the property, whilst a convenient cloakroom completes the ground floor.

On the first floor are two well-proportioned double bedrooms served by a family bathroom. The second floor is dedicated to an impressive principal bedroom suite, offering excellent levels of privacy and space, together with the added convenience of an en-suite shower room.

Outside

Outside, the property benefits from allocated off-road parking to the front. The rear garden is fully enclosed and has been thoughtfully designed for ease of maintenance, featuring a generous paved terrace ideal for entertaining, together with an attractive raised planted border and an area of lawn. The property has allocated parking as well.

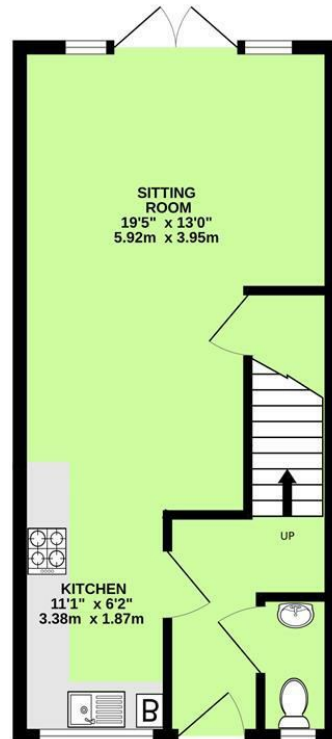

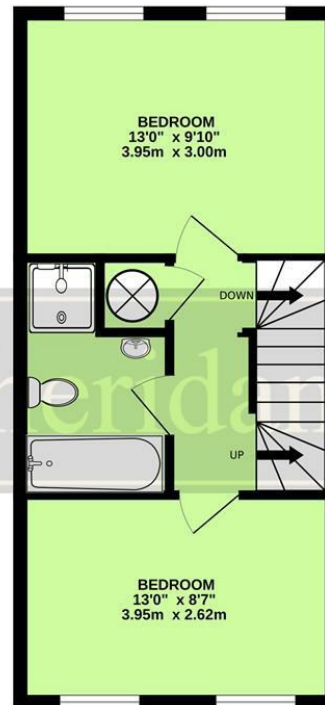

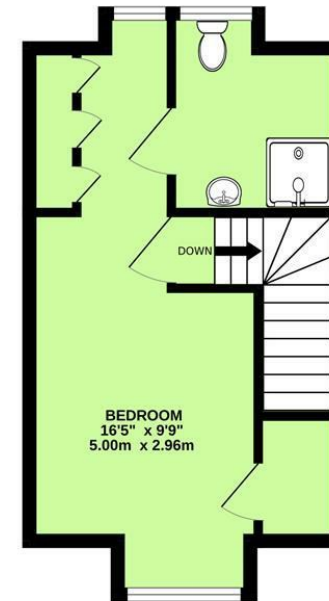
GROUND FLOOR
