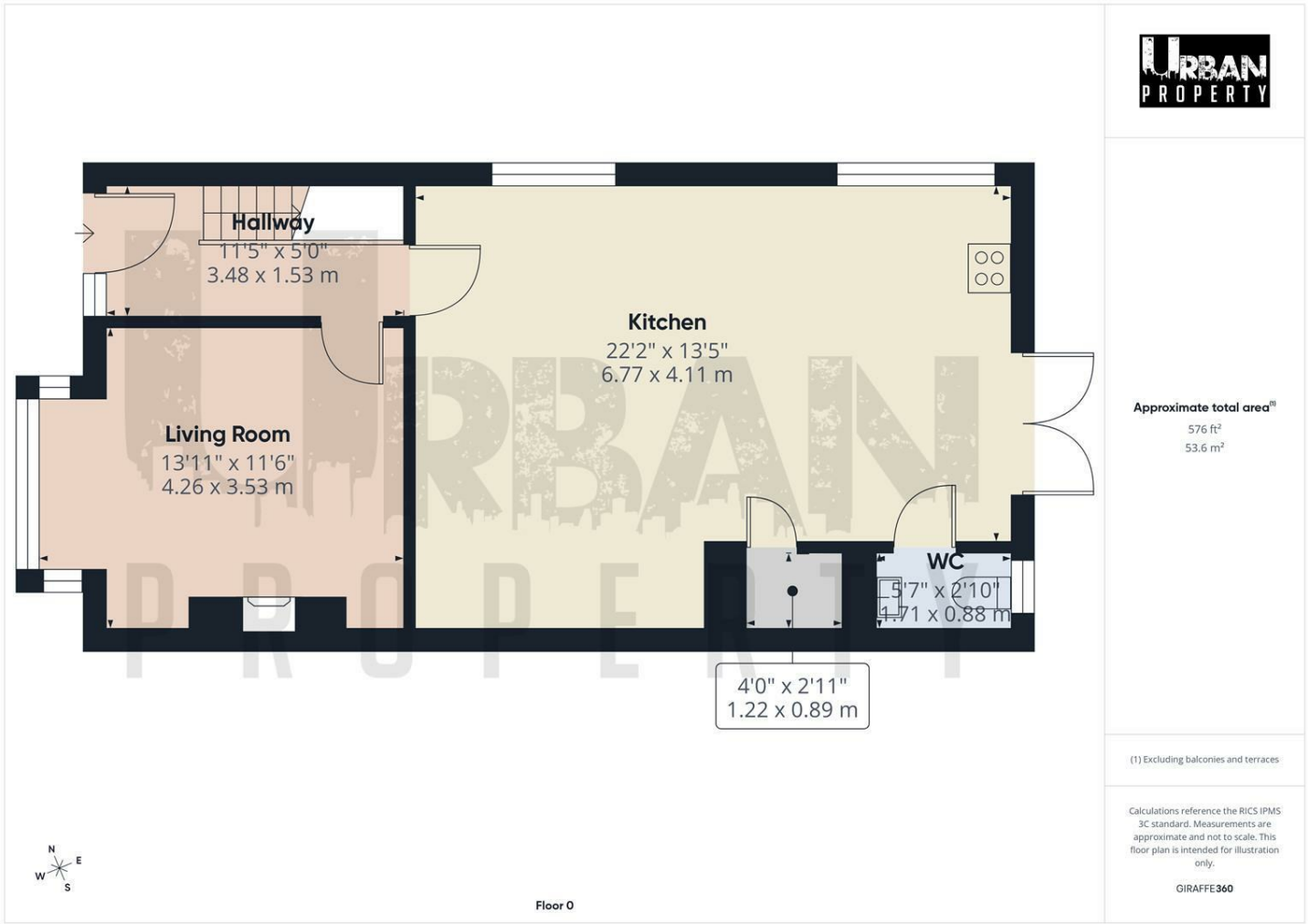
To the first floor are three well-proportioned double bedrooms and a modern family bathroom.

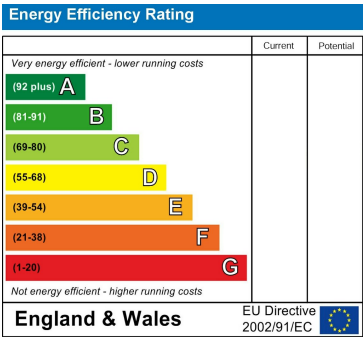
Floor Plan
