This attractive 1930's bay fronted home has been extended to create a living space of over 1000 sq ft and has the extremely rare benefit of a stylish detached 1 bedroom annexe to the rear - ideal for a variety of living arrangements.

The property benefits from an impressive plot with the West-facing rear garden measuring approx 90ft, along with a driveway to the front offering parking for numerous vehicles, and is conveniently situated within a stone's throw of Corsham's picturesque High Street and the hugely popular Corsham Primary School - Pound Pill Site.

The light & airy accommodation starts with an entrance porch leading into a traditional hallway, bay fronted living room to the front, and a fantastic kitchen/dining room to the rear, opening into a useful garden room. There is a utility room off of the kitchen with a downstairs cloakroom/wc.

On the first floor are two double bedrooms, both with an array of built-in storage, with the front room having a bay window. A further single bedroom has a built-in storage cupboard. A stylish shower room has been recently fitted with a large walk-in shower.

To the rear of the property is a fantastic recently built one bedroom annexe, with a light & airy open plan living room/kitchen, double bedroom with built-in wardrobes, and a beautifully fitted shower room.

There is a fantastic rear garden that enjoys a good level of privacy along with a wonderfully sunny south-westerly aspect - perfect for entertaining and plenty of space for green fingered gardeners to enjoy.

Corsham is a historic market town on the southwestern edge of the Cotswolds, just off the A4 national route, which was formerly the main turnpike road from London to Bristol, between Bath and Chippenham.
