THE PROPERTY

Located just a short stroll from the attractive town centre amenities, including a Waitrose supermarket and the Aquacentre swimming and fitness complex, this substantial Grade II listed property offers far more than first impressions suggest. Available with no onward chain, it is an ideal choice for buyers seeking the convenience of town living while retaining the character and generous proportions of a traditional period home.

ACCOMMODATION

A traditional hallway with decorative tiled floor leads to a generous living room at the front of the house, with a stone open fireplace and period features including decorative alcoves and picture rails. The characterful kitchen has exposed ceiling beams and a range of fitted units incorporating electric oven and hob, and space for your washing machine. On the first floor there are two generous double bedrooms including one with a good range of fitted wardrobes. There is also a separate shower room. A further staircase leads up to an attractive attic bedroom on the second floor.

OUTSIDE

To the front, adjoining Cossins Lane, is a paved courtyard area with shrubs, bordered by a low stone wall. Vine House has a right of access over Cossins Lane to reach its

detached garage which lies within a stone's throw of the property on the west side of Cossins Lane. At the rear of Vine House is a small, sheltered courtyard garden, with a south-westerly aspect. Laid to paving, a stone wall and gate separates it from the gardens belonging to the neighbouring Orchard House.

SITUATION

Crewkerne is a pretty and friendly market town. Its predominantly neo-Georgian and Victorian town centre streets offer a range of high street stores including a Waitrose supermarket and many independent retailers, a range of local pubs, cafés, large indoor swimming pool and gym complex. The town has several schools covering all age groups. Crewkerne is well served in terms of public services with its own small hospital, GP surgeries and dentists. Mainline railway station (London Waterloo – Exeter) whose nearest stops include the larger town of Yeovil, and historic Abbey town of Sherborne. To the west the line heads down towards the Dorset coast. The Jurassic Coast World Heritage Site including the famous sea-side town of Lyme Regis, lies about 30 minutes' away.

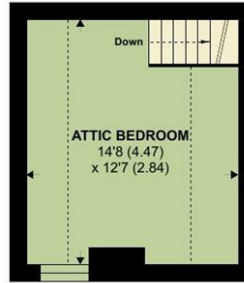

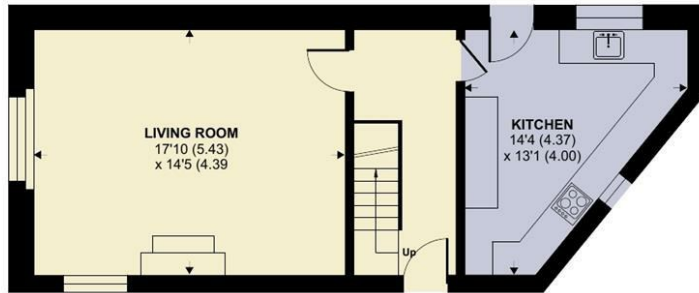
