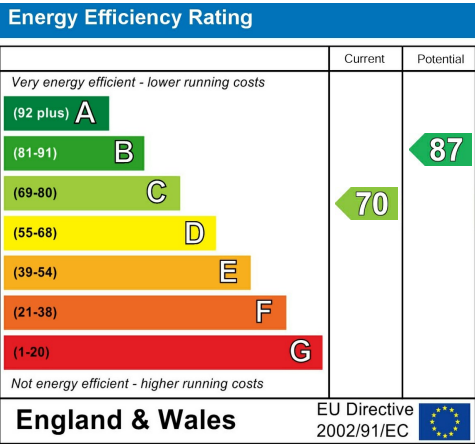
FLOOR PLAN
