This deceptive three bedroom detached bungalow is ideally situated in a quiet development, just a short walk from the local shops and bus route. The property offers bright and spacious accommodation, with features including an L-shaped sitting/dining room, two double bedrooms, a generous driveway, and a secluded southwest facing garden.

The Property

Entrance porch with a UPVC double glazed front door, a UPVC window, a double storage cupboard, and a glazed door leading through to the sitting/dining room.

The sitting/dining room has a feature fireplace with a stone surround and hearth, an inset living flame gas fire, a bright triple aspect, a large picture window overlooking the rear garden, a modern central heating thermostat, and a sliding door leading through to the kitchen.

The kitchen is fitted with a range of solid wood wall and base units, a contrasting worktop, a one and a half bowl sink with a mixer tap and drainer, a tiled splashback, and a Glow Worm central heating boiler installed in November 2025. Integrated appliances include an eye level double oven and a four burner gas hob with an extractor fan above. There is space and plumbing for an under counter fridge, and a UPVC door provides access to the garden.

The internal hallway has a hatch to the loft space, useful coat hooks, a radiator, and an airing cupboard with slatted shelves for storage.

Family bathroom with timber effect flooring, part tiled walls, and a suite comprising a WC, a pedestal wash hand basin, a panel bath with an independent electric shower, a shower curtain, and a UPVC window.

Bedrooms one and two are both lovely double rooms situated at the front of the property, each with a large UPVC window and ample space for storage.

Bedroom three overlooks the driveway and would make an ideal home office or guest bedroom.

The bungalow has a mixture of double glazed and triple glazed windows.





Gardens & Grounds

The front of the property is laid to lawn, with mature borders and a dwarf brick wall. A tarmac driveway provides parking for three to four vehicles and gives access to the single garage, which has an up and over door.

The rear garden enjoys a bright, sunny southwesterly aspect and is surrounded by high hedging and fencing, making it extremely private and secluded. A patio adjoins the rear of the property, with the remainder of the garden laid to lawn, with mature borders, a side gate providing access to the driveway, and a rear pedestrian door into the back of the garage.

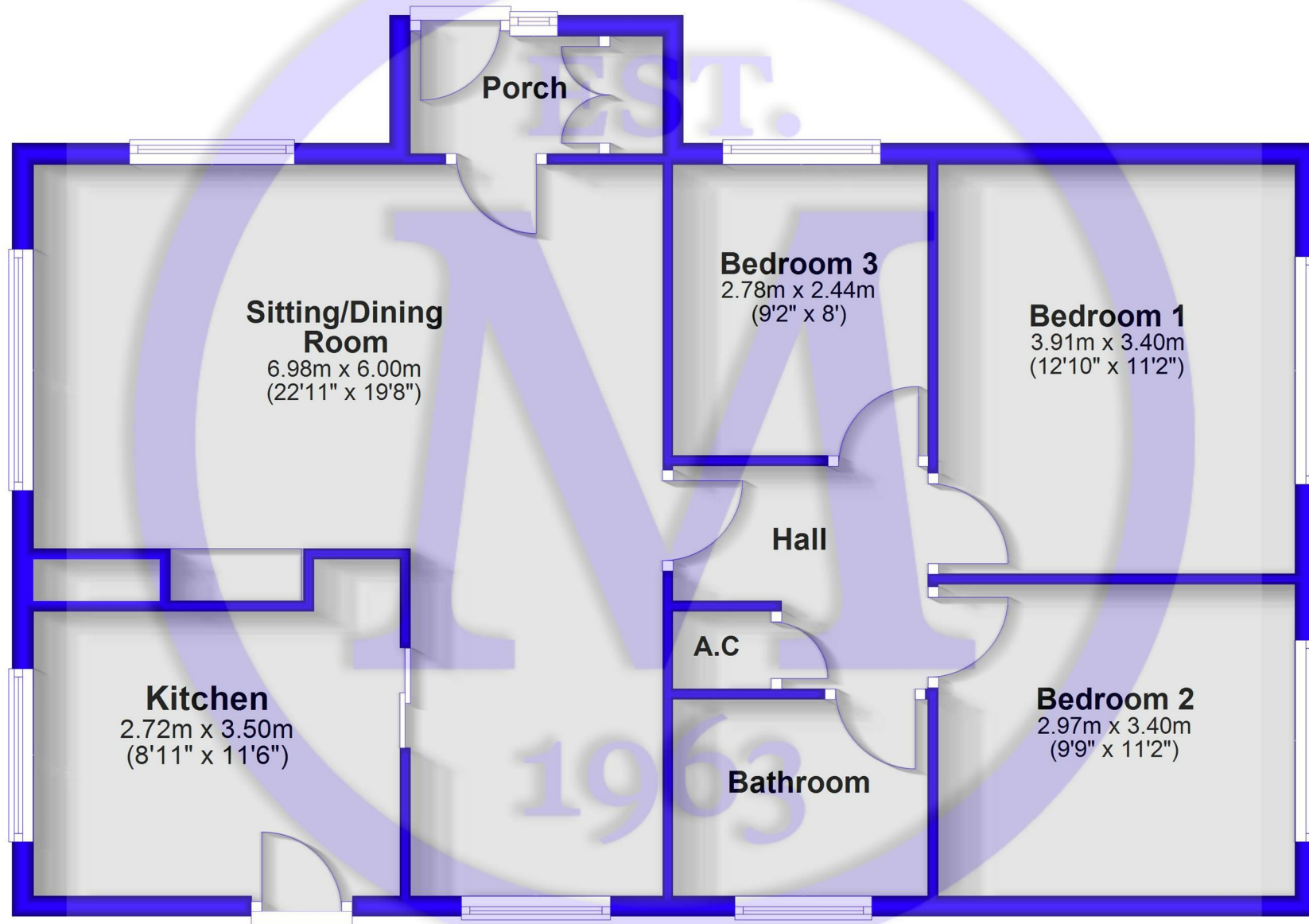

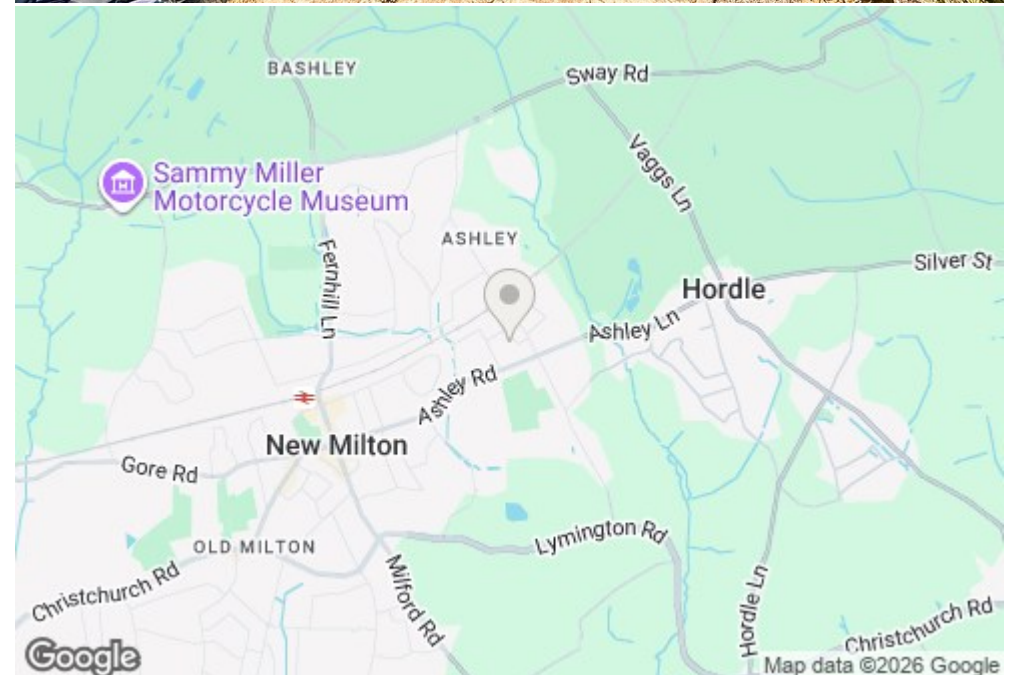
