The Property

Rose Cottage is an individually built detached bungalow discreetly tucked away in the centre of Sherston and only a moment's walk from the High Street and its many amenities. The property has been recently refurbished and extended enhancing its unique appeal and is tastefully finished. In addition to a significant side extension, the electrics and plumbing have all been upgraded. The light and bright accommodation extends to around 913 sq.ft. and is surrounded by pretty wraparound gardens.

The configuration includes a new entrance hall with a convenient utility/WC off. A dining room flows superbly to both a private courtyard terrace and the adjoining kitchen. The newly fitted kitchen is well-appointed with integrated appliances including a dishwasher, oven, microwave, and induction hob, complemented by a walk-in pantry. Bathed in natural light from its southerly dual-aspect, the living room offers a welcoming

atmosphere centred around a cosy wood-burning stove. There are two bedrooms both with built-in wardrobes while the bathroom has been updated as a stylish shower room. An inner hallway provides a useful area for a desk beside fitted storage and shelving.

The gardens wraparound the bungalow to include a south-facing lawned area surrounded by vibrant beds and a secluded courtyard style patio terrace, perfect for alfresco dining. A picturesque private path leads to the property, setting it back from the street. On-street parking is readily available on Noble Street.

Situation

The beautiful, ancient and much sought after village of Sherston with its broad High Street and historic stone houses is set in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty conveniently located on the edge of the Cotswolds. Sherston has a thriving community and offers many facilities, including a church, popular

primary school, doctors surgery, Co-op shop and post office, coffee shops, hairdresser, Indian restaurant, garden centre and the highly regarded 16th century Rattlebone Inn, with its excellent food and friendly atmosphere. The facilities and amenities in Sherston more than adequately provide for everyday need with a whole host of societies and clubs meeting on a regular basis offering entertainment and social events for young and old alike. Schooling locally is second to none, with very good state and independent schools providing transport to and from the village on a daily basis. Close by are the market towns of Malmesbury and Tetbury which are both approximately 5 miles away. Malmesbury is reputed to be the oldest Borough in the country dating back to the 11th Century. Both towns offer a wider range of shops, services, schooling and leisure facilities. There are main line stations to London-Paddington at Kemble (14 miles) and Chippenham (12 miles) whilst Junctions 17 & 18 of the M4 are both within 15 minutes' drive providing convenient access to Bath, Bristol and Swindon.

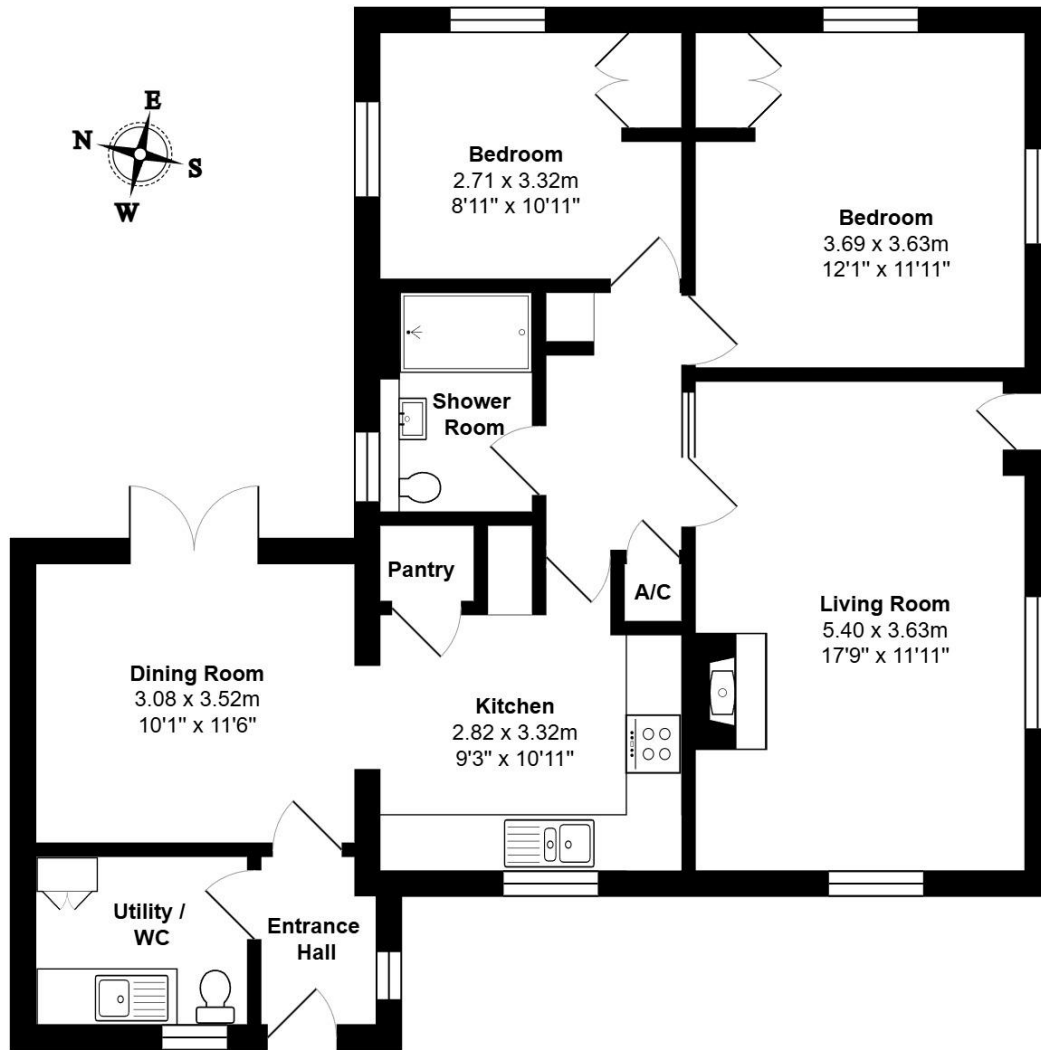
