STRIKING GRADE II LISTED COTTAGE

This striking Grade II Listed cottage dates from the 1750s and has recently undergone a top to toe renovation including a stunning kitchen extension to provide an immaculately presented home retaining the original character and features whilst providing the convenience of modern living.

The accommodation consists of an entrance lobby leading into the sitting room with exposed beams, oak flooring and feature fireplace with log burning stove, a study, stunning light filled vaulted kitchen/dining room with bi-fold doors to the terrace, a utility room and a ground floor bedroom with ensuite Jack 'n' Jill shower room.

On the first floor there are two double bedrooms each with exposed beams, oak flooring and in one room a fireplace. There is also a family bathroom. Both the bathroom and the shower room have underfloor heating.

The cottage sits in grounds of approximately 0.25 acres with gated off-road parking for several cars. There is a detached outbuilding which is used as a workshop and benefits from electricity, ceramic heating and high-speed broadband. The lawn has a drainage system installed whilst the majority of the flower beds are drip irrigated. The well-stocked garden includes three mature walnut trees and a variety of roses.



HAWKHURST

Hawkhurst offers a selection of shops including a Chemist, Butcher/Provision Store, Florist, Bakers, Hairdressers, Petrol Station, two local Supermarkets a Tesco and a Waitrose, a number of Restaurants and an "Art" Cinema to name but a few.

Other local facilities include two doctors' practices, a vets, opticians and dentist. Sports clubs are available in the form of Squash, Tennis, Badminton and Golf.

More extensive facilities are available in Tunbridge Wells.

SCHOOLS AND CONNECTIONS

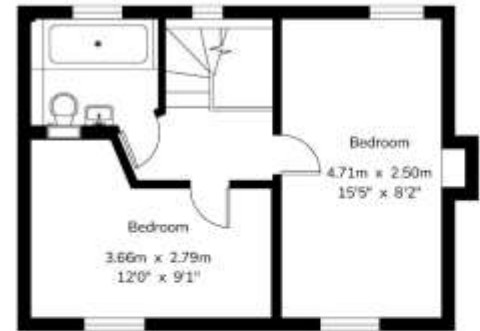
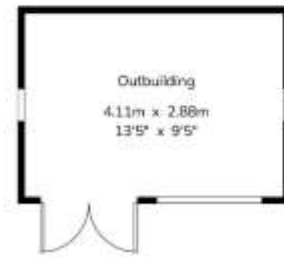
