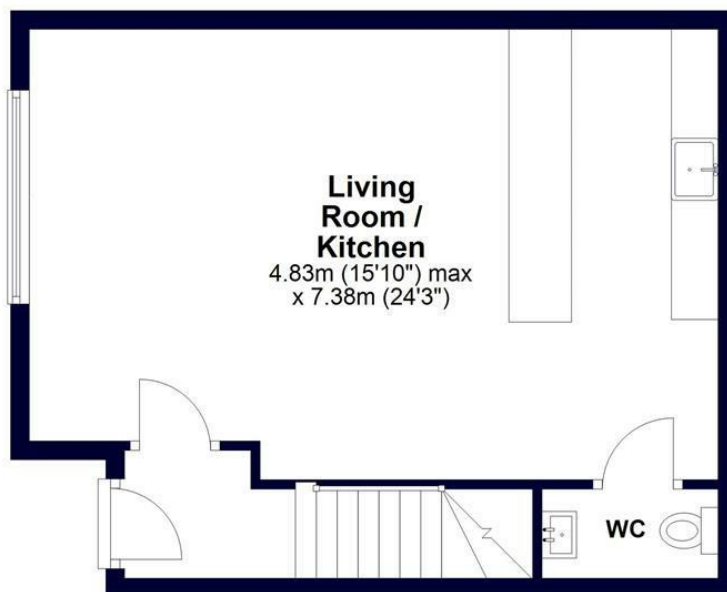

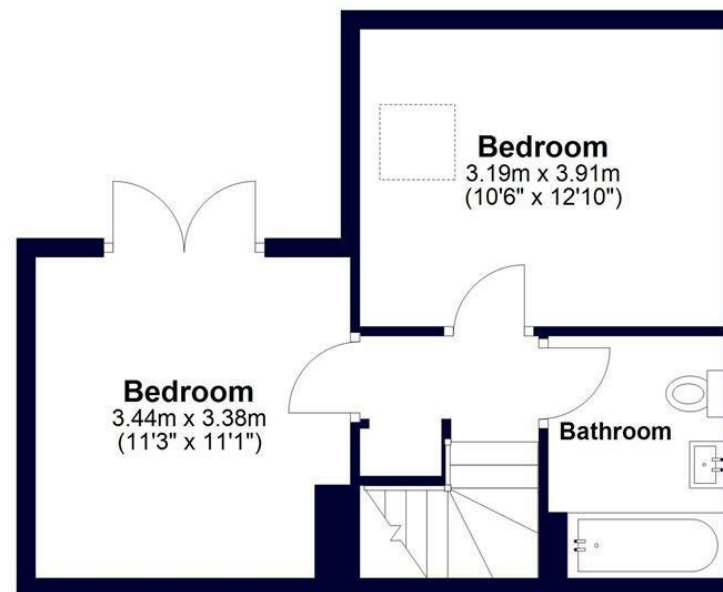
Ground Floor
