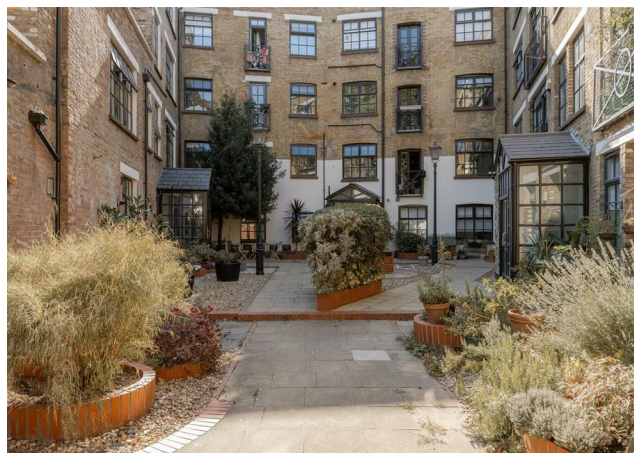

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IF YOU LIVED HERE...

At around 780 sq ft, the apartment has a naturally bright interior and a well-planned layout. The south-facing reception room is a real focal point, with wood flooring and windows across two sides drawing in plenty of daylight. There's room for distinct sitting and dining areas, while glazed double doors lead through to the separate kitchen. Here, red cabinetry brings a confident hit of colour, with plenty of worktop and storage space. The bathroom is accessed from the hallway and has a bath with shower above.

Both bedrooms sit separately from the main living space. The larger bedroom has an extensive run of fitted wardrobes, while the second is currently arranged as a home office, showing how easily the room can adapt to different needs. The apartment is beautifully presented throughout, with a mix of warm flooring, neutral walls and carefully chosen colour. The gated development also comes with private parking for a car, two secure bike sheds and an on-site gym, alongside a planted communal courtyard.

WHAT ELSE?

Dalston is close at hand for a great mix of independent food and drink, including The Dusty Knuckle, Acme Fire Cult and Mangal II, alongside the shops and stalls around Ridley Road Market. Stoke Newington is nearby too, with Church Street offering plenty of independent places to eat and drink, while Clissold Park gives you another excellent stretch of green space. Dalston Kingsland and Dalston Junction Overground stations are both within easy reach, providing useful connections across East and North London, with plenty of local bus routes running through the surrounding area.
