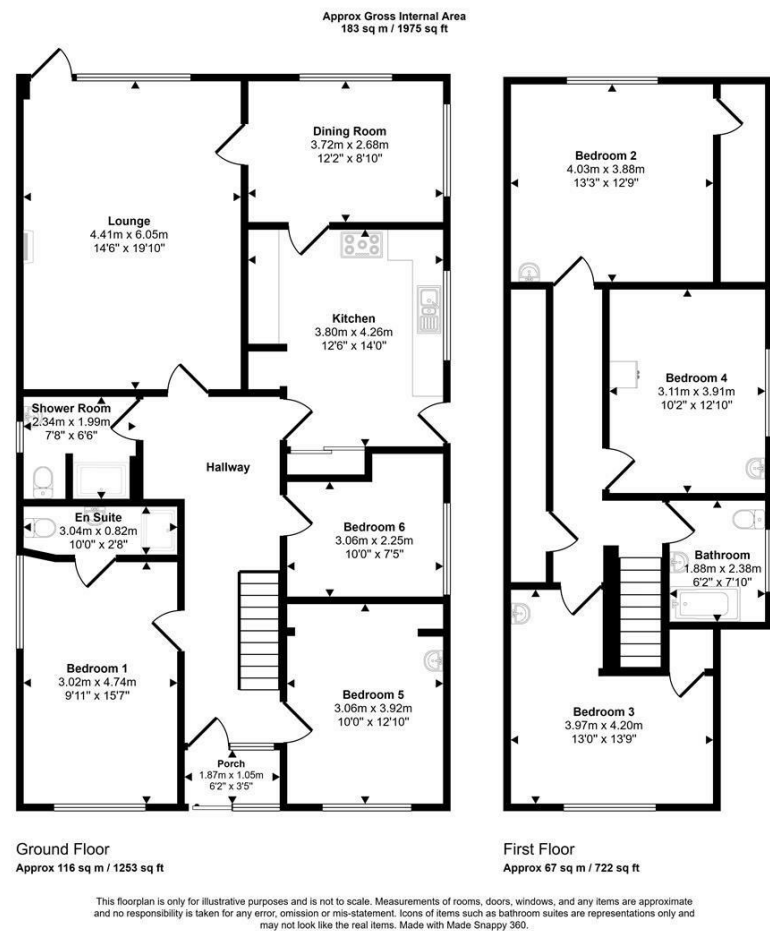

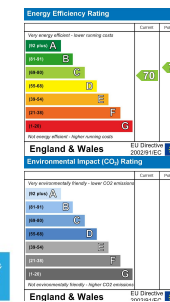

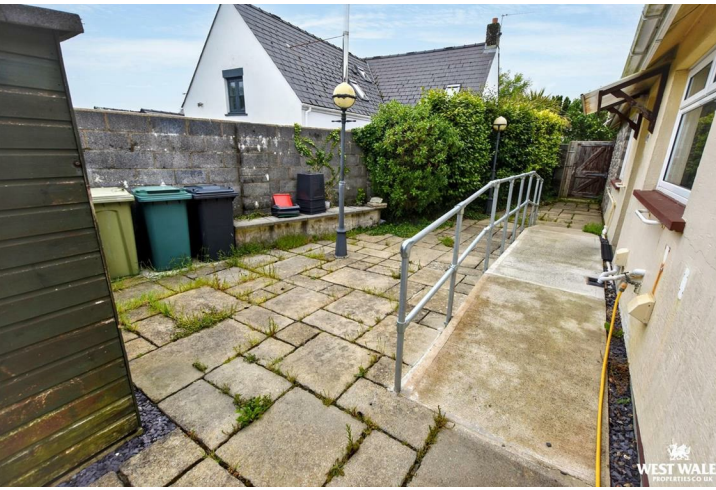
The property benefits from double glazing, gas central heating, and is offered to the market with no onward chain.
