Welcome Home

“A sanctuary of style and substance located in the sleepy village of Blythe Bridge and wrapped inside the Staffordshire Moorlands”

Nestled within a private, gated development comprising just three exclusive properties, The Stables sits in the heart of Blythe Bridge. This rural village is surrounded by the sprawling Staffordshire Moorlands, with a wealth of excellent walks from the doorstep. Blythe Bridge is celebrated for its sought-after schools and traditional village pubs, yet it remains an oasis of calm with a friendly community spirit.

Inside this five-bedroom, detached home, meticulously crafted spaces await. Measuring 287sq.m across three floors, the property has been designed with the modern family in mind.



Private Personal Sanctuary



Access The Stables via electric gates, operated by an intercom system, where a generous driveway with space for up to five cars greets you. Leave the world outside as you enter your personal sanctuary.

This is a home that understands the art of living. Every detail, from the wooden flooring and elegant tiles to the play of light across each of the rooms, has been considered. It offers contemporary country living, a place for families to grow and for friends to gather.

Step into the bright, expansive entrance hall that sets the tone for what lies beyond. Underfoot, white tiles, warmed by underfloor heating, give a real sense of modern luxury, and a useful guest cloakroom lies to the right. The sculptural solid oak staircase and balustrade create a gallery-like first impression, both welcoming and sophisticated. From this central hub, the home unfolds around you.



Family Home Designed for Connection

To your left, the principal living space reveals itself as natural light floods in from three elevations, dancing on the wooden flooring and illuminating the focal point: a multi-fuel burner set within a recessed fireplace.

Double doors form a seamless bridge to the private, paved patio, an outdoor space waiting to be dressed for morning coffee or evening drinks.





The dining area, defined by a striking bare-brick feature wall, flows effortlessly from the kitchen and opens via its own bi-fold doors onto the patio, creating an indoor-outdoor flow. For all the accoutrements of country living, a separate utility room houses a sink, pantry cupboard and dedicated appliance spaces, with a back door leading out to the garden.




Return through the entrance hall to enter the true heart of the home – a spacious, open-plan family kitchen and dining area. A chef’s dream, the kitchen boasts sleek pale-grey cabinetry, flawless quartz worktops sweeping around a central island and a range-style cooker anchoring the room within a chimney-breast recess. This is a space designed for connection, whether you’re preparing a family breakfast, hosting a dinner party or simply enjoying the buzz of a busy household.





Serene Realm

From the reception hall, ascend the stairs to the first floor, where you enter a serene realm of four private bedrooms. The layout is both generous and thoughtful. Bedroom two is generous in size and boasts an ensuite shower room. Bedroom three features a beautifully appointed ensuite with a curved shower, mosaic tiles and that all-important walk-in-wardrobe.







Head up the second staircase that leads to a garret-like space. Here, a fifth double bedroom captures the imagination. This Master bedroom is the undisputed star of the home and feels like a penthouse hideaway with its characterful sloping ceilings and two large Velux windows that flood the room with sunlight. Served by a generous bathroom with a roll-top bath and shower, dressing area and a versatile storage room that could serve as a walk-in wardrobe or a quiet study.

Return to the ground floor and access the integral garage from the kitchen, which offers more than mere storage with space for an additional car. Step outside, and a private outdoor sanctuary unfolds. The wrap-around gardens provide two distinct, expansive lawned areas, framed by mature hedges and timber fencing, perfect for slow mornings or entertaining friends and family.


Penthouse Hideaway




First Floor
