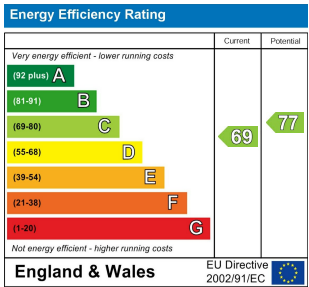

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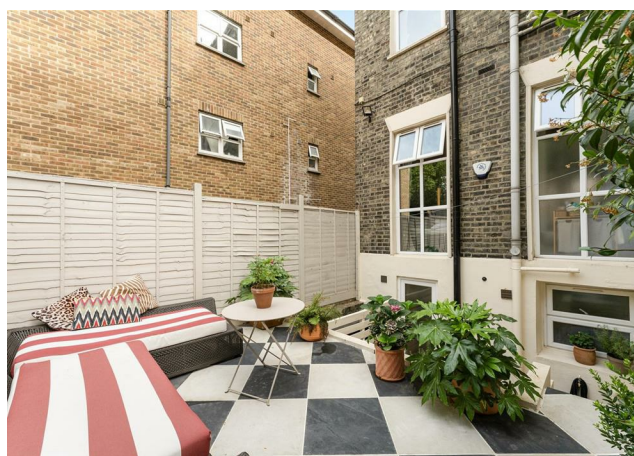
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IF YOU LIVED HERE....

Set on the lower ground floor, the apartment opens into a spacious reception room with timber flooring, large windows and built-in shelving. There's plenty of room to create distinct areas for lounging and dining, while the arched opening into the separate kitchen gives the two spaces an easy connection. Dark cabinetry and timber worktops bring warmth to the kitchen, with a window drawing in natural light. The hallway adds an impressive amount of built-in storage, keeping everyday clutter tucked away.

Towards the rear, the bedroom feels calm and characterful, with a rich colour palette and room for a double bed and further storage. Next door, the bathroom has a bath with shower above, along with a marble-topped vanity unit and matching marble shelf. Best of all, the bedroom opens straight onto the very large private garden. It starts with a paved area for a table and chairs before continuing into the planted garden beyond, giving you plenty of room for summer dinners, a morning coffee or gardening. There's also a communal garden to the rear, adding even more outdoor

space to enjoy.

WHAT ELSE?

- Clapton has become a real neighbourhood hub for eating, drinking and keeping active. You've got Ayva and The Clapton Hart nearby, while BLOK Clapton offers fitness classes from its striking former tram depot home.

- Hackney Downs Park is moments away for open green space and tennis courts, with Lower Clapton Road and Clarence Road putting a great mix of independent cafés, shops and places to eat within easy reach.

- Clapton Station is just moments from home for Overground services, while Hackney Downs and Hackney Central add further connections across East London and towards the City.
