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Entrance Hall

Accessed via a glazed door with side panel, stairs leading up to first floor with open storage area under and doors leading to ground floor accommodation.

Living Room

A generous room with large window to the front aspect.

Kitchen/Diner

Open plan kitchen diner with a selection of base and wall mounted cupboards, rolled edge worktops, double drainer sink unit, space for oven, part tiled flooring and walls, sliding doors from dining area leading out to rear garden, pantry cupboard and door leading to utility.

Utility Room and WC

Plumbing for washing machine and space for further appliances, window to rear aspect and door leading outside. There is a door to WC with toilet and wash basin.

First Floor Landing

Cupboard housing boiler and hot water tank. There is a frosted window to the side aspect and access to partially boarded loft space.

Bedroom One

Window to the rear aspect.

Bedroom Two

A range of built in wardrobe storage and window to the front aspect.

Bedroom Three

Window to the front aspect.

Shower Room

Wet room style flooring, direct feed shower, WC, wash basin and frosted window to rear aspect.

Outside

To the front of the property is a garden mainly laid to lawn with mature shrub borders and path leading to the front



door. Gated side access leads to the rear garden which has an area of lawn, pleasant patio and seating area and access into the garage via pedestrian door at its rear. Rear gated access to parking space and garage.

Location

Newent originally called Noent is a small market town about 8 miles north west of Gloucester, on the northern edge of the Forest of Dean. The town includes a half-timbered market house, plus other houses of historical nature and Newent Lake a large picturesque lake in the centre of the town, originally part of the Newent Court Estate is the 'jewel of the town'. The town is served by three schools, all within the town, a doctors surgery and dentist, Sports & Leisure Centre and various churches of different denominations. With excellent motorway links to the M50 & M5.

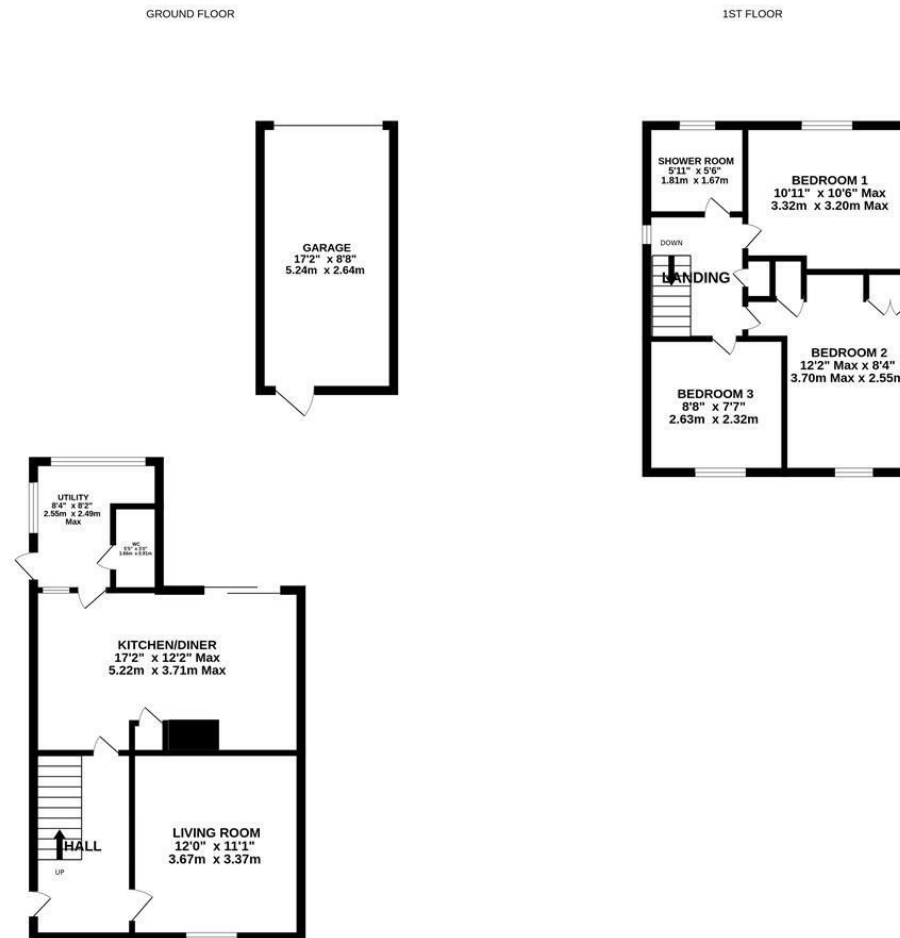
