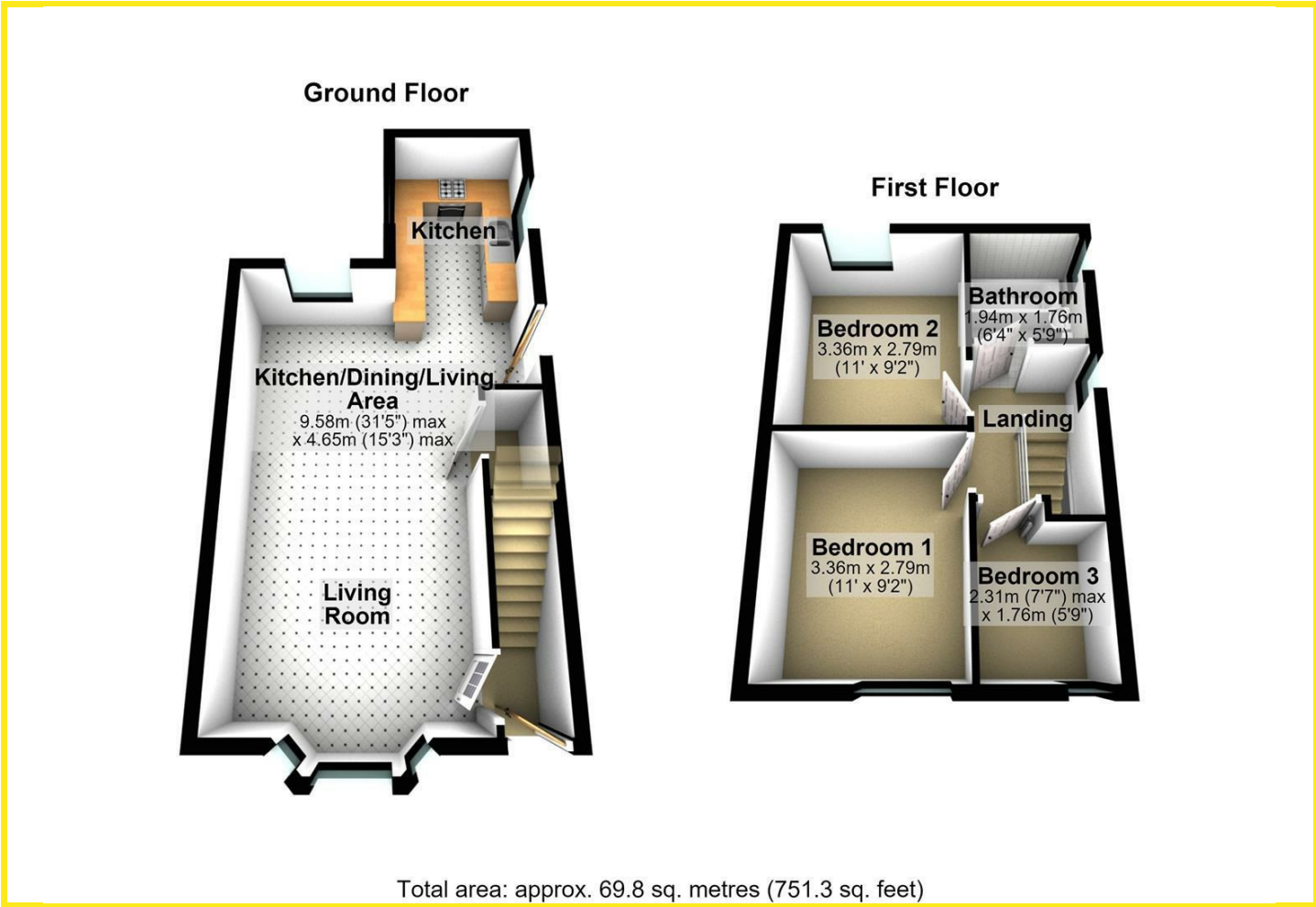

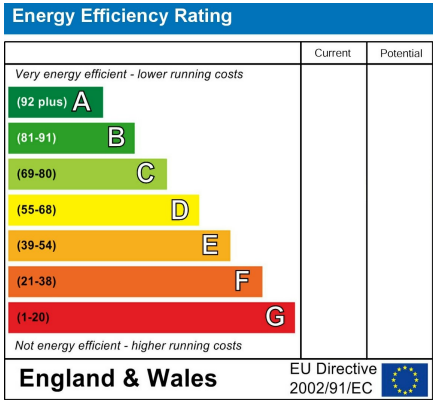
Floor Plan

From this direction Lynnfield Gardens will be the second turning off on the right hand side.
