The outside decked seating area has been well thought out offering what feels like an inside space, but outside! Upstairs are two bedrooms, the master with a lovely tall ceiling & single bedroom looking over the garden.

Externally there is a fabulous lengthy rear garden, laid mostly to gravel and full of surprises & views all the way down. The undercover seating area with hot tub works well overlooking the garden with different areas for a BBQ, keeping chickens, shed storage and even some raised beds for growing veggies.
