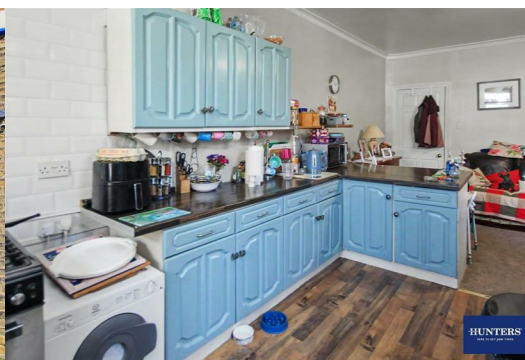

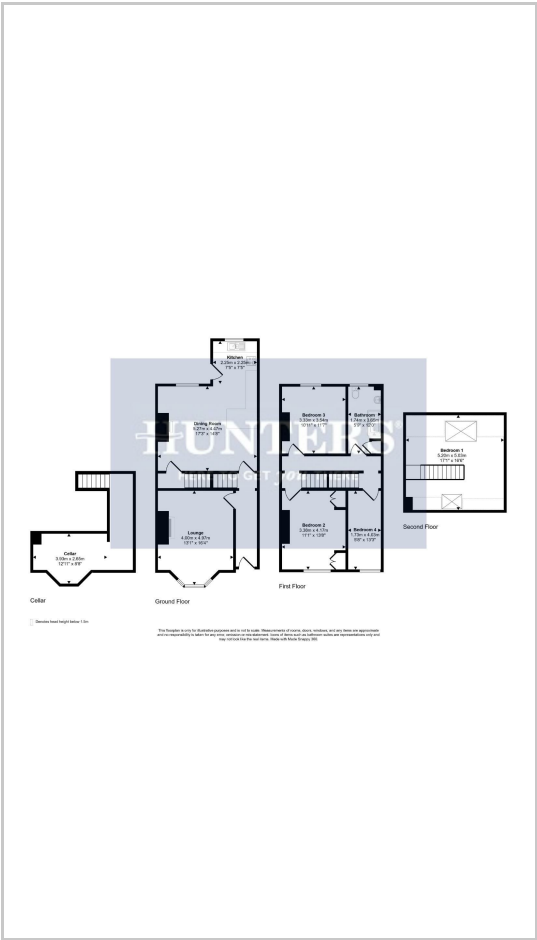

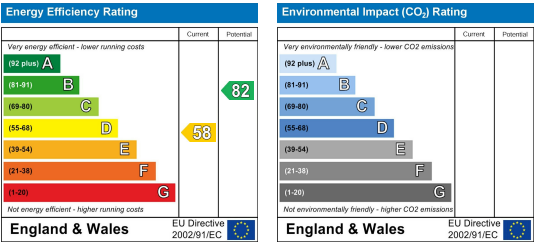
Area Map
