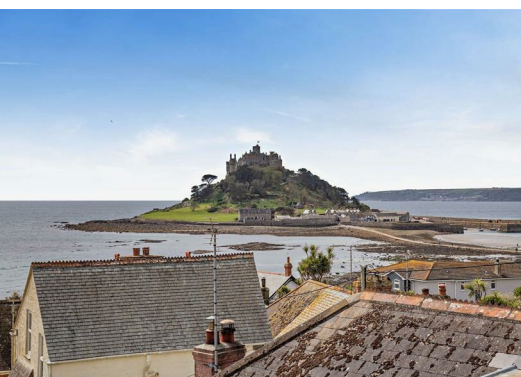

Situated in the charming seaside town of Marazion, this exceptional coastal property offers breathtaking sea views and an enviable position just moments from the shoreline. With uninterrupted vistas from all rear-facing windows—including the master bedroom—this home enjoys spectacular outlooks towards the world-famous St Michael’s Mount.

Rising dramatically from the sea, St Michael’s Mount is a historic tidal island crowned by a medieval castle and 12th-century chapel. Managed by the National Trust and the St Aubyn family, the island is accessed via a granite causeway at low tide or by boat at high tide, offering a truly unique and ever-changing coastal backdrop.

In addition to its rich history, the Mount has gained international recognition through its appearances in film and television. Most notably, it featured in House of the Dragon, where it was transformed into High Tide—the ancestral seat of House Velaryon on the island of Driftmark. Its dramatic coastline and medieval architecture made it an ideal filming location, showcasing its striking and atmospheric presence to a global audience.

The Mount also appeared in the popular film Johnny English, further cementing its status as one of the UK’s most visually captivating landmarks. Over the years, it has been used in numerous other productions, thanks to its unique tidal setting and fairy-tale silhouette—adding an extra layer of prestige and fascination to the views enjoyed from the property.

The location offers immediate access to the coast, with the nearest beach just a one-minute walk away, and the wide sandy stretches of Mount’s Bay only a few minutes further through the village—perfect for seaside living at its finest.

Marazion itself provides a delightful selection of local amenities, including independent shops, a newsagent, general store, pharmacy, and gift boutiques. Dining options include the highly regarded The Godolphin, where guests can enjoy food and drink with panoramic views of St Michael’s Mount. Nearby, Philps Bakery offers freshly baked bread and traditional Cornish pasties daily.

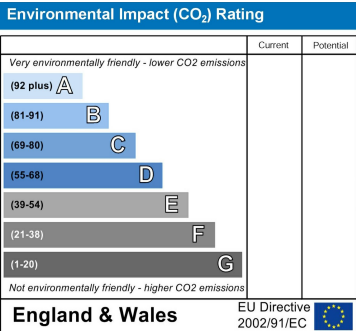
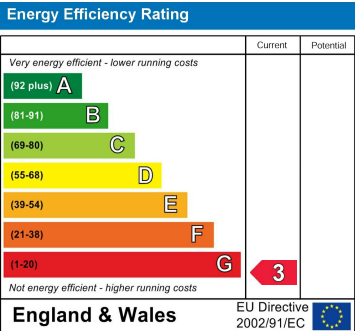
