Bedroom - 3.51m x 3.02m (11'6 x 9'11) - Window to rear, built in wardrobe, built in cupboard housing the gas central heating boiler and radiator.

Shower Room - Shower cubicle, concealed cistern wc, wash hand basin with cupboard below, extractor fan, radiator.

Outside - Slate gravel garden, with paved patio area, and raised flower beds.

Communal Garden - Shared raised communal gardens with space for bins and seating area.

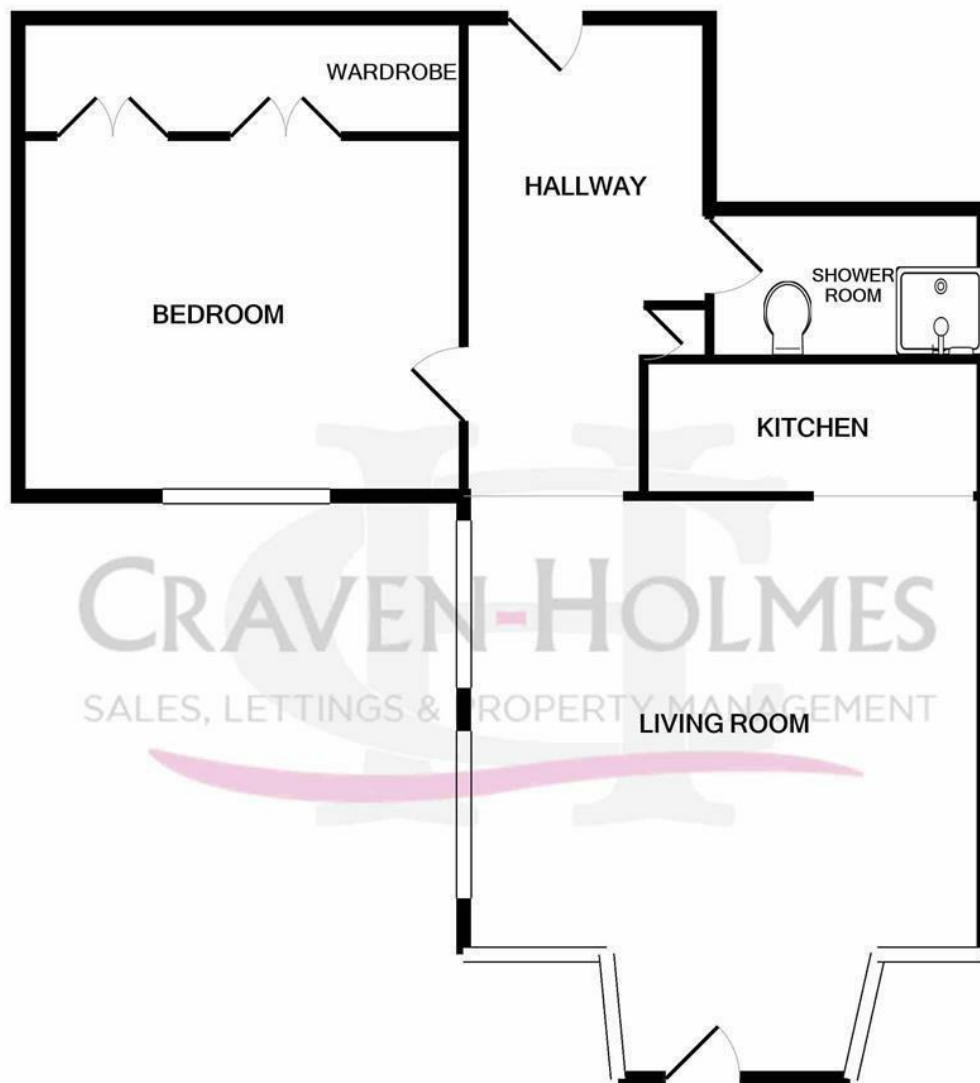

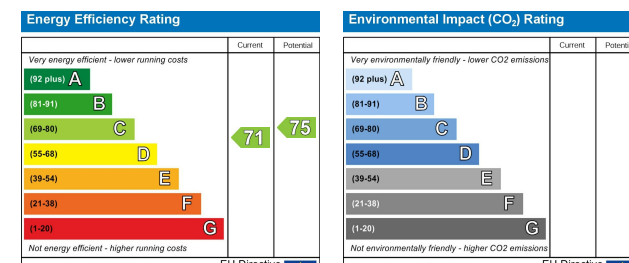
