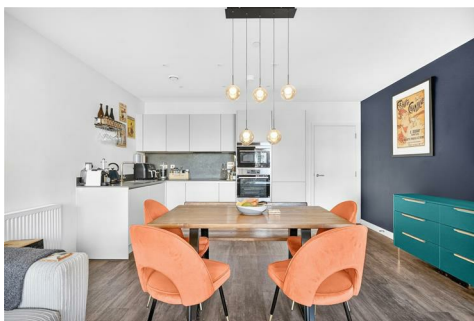




Clarkson Crescent, Walthamstow, London

A beautifully presented two-bedroom modern apartment situated on the second floor of the sought-after Feature 17 Countryside development right next to Wood Street.

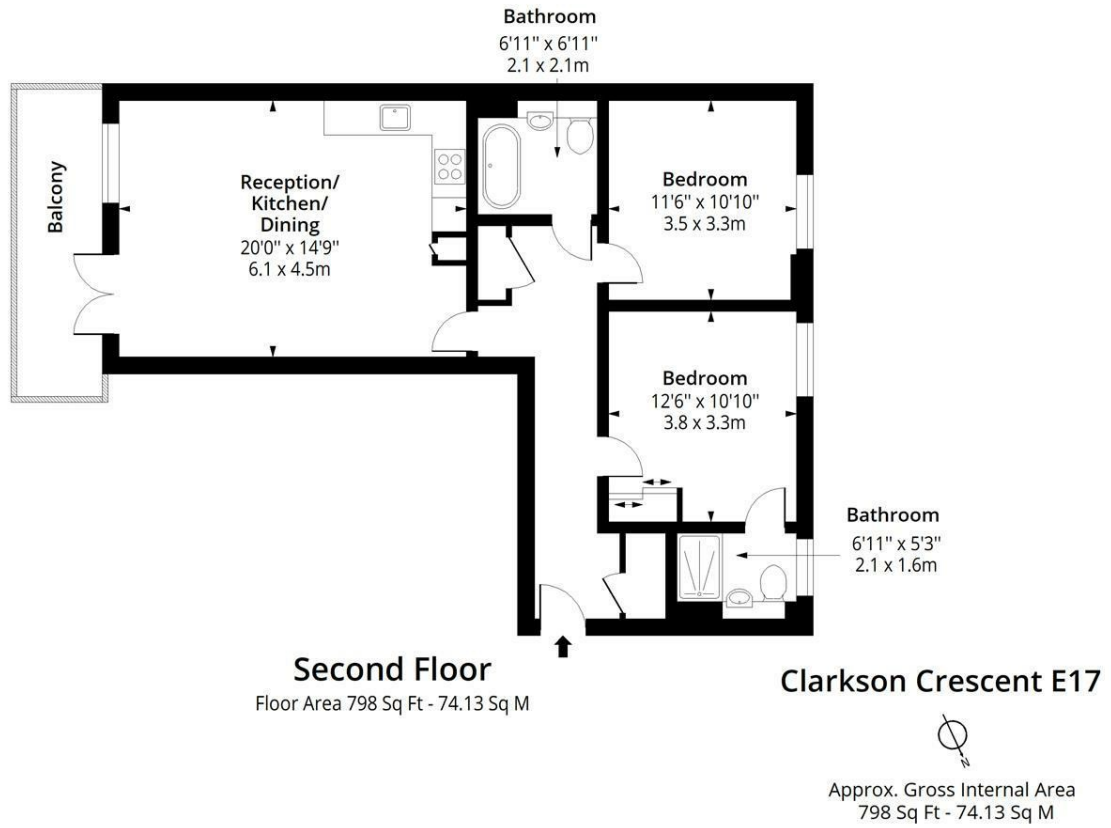
