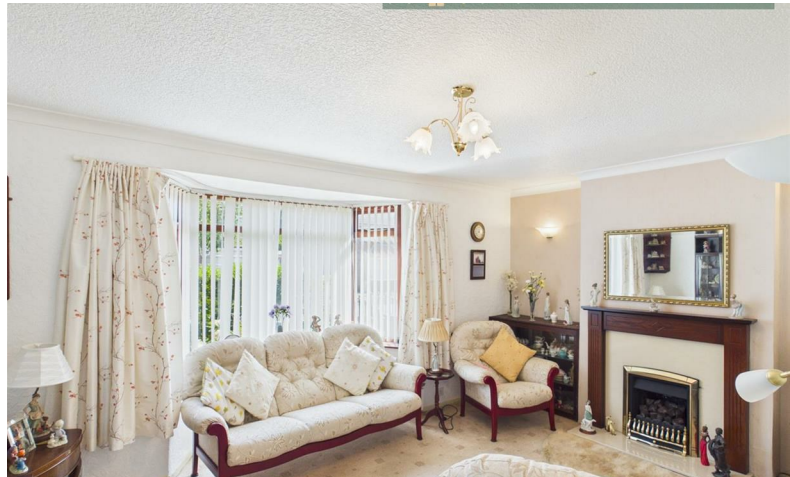

Hallway

Neutral decor, radiator, stairs leading to first floor, pendant lighting.

Lounge

15'11 x 11'1 (4.85m x 3.38m)

Leading from the hallway, neutral décor, feature gas fire, bay front uPVC window & pendant lighting.

Dining Room

12'7 x 8'2 (3.84m x 2.49m)

Neutral décor, carpeted, pendant lighting, radiator, window to the rear and access to the kitchen. Door to under stair storage.

Kitchen

5'11 x 11'0 (1.80m x 3.35m)

Fully tiled kitchen with a range of wall and base units, space for cooker, washing machine, & under counter fridge. Vinyl flooring, and pendant lighting, window and door to the rear.

WC

2'8 x 5'2 (0.81m x 1.57m)

Neutral décor WC, window, pendant lighting.

Stairs & Landing

6'0 x 8'8 (1.83m x 2.64m)

Neutral décor, Double hand rail, carpeted, access to loft

Bedroom One

9'7 x 11'3 (2.92m x 3.43m)

To the Front of the property, neutral décor, carpets, radiator, window, storage cupboard, pendant lighting.

Bedroom Two

10'10 x 8'5 (3.30m x 2.57m)

To the rear of the property, neutral décor, carpets, radiator, window, storage cupboard, pendant lighting.

Bedroom Three

6'0 x 8'2 (1.83m x 2.49m)

To the front of the property, neutral décor, carpets, radiator, window, storage cupboard, pendant lighting.

Bathroom

4'8 x 5'2 (1.42m x 1.57m)

Fully tiled shower room. window, electric shower and cubicle, pedestal wash basin.

Garage

To the rear with up double doors, perfect for additional storage.

External

The property boast a large driveway for multiple cars, front garden area and rear patio with lawned garden.

Stamp Duty Land Tax

Residential property rates

You usually pay Stamp Duty Land Tax (SDLT) on increasing portions of the property price when you buy residential property, for example a house or flat.

The amount you pay depends on:

- when you bought the property
- how much you paid for it
- whether you're eligible for relief or an exemption

Rates for a single property

You pay SDLT at these rates if, after buying the property, it is the only residential property you own.

You will usually pay 5% on top of these rates if you own another residential property.

Rates from 1 April 2025

Property or lease premium or transfer value SDLT rate

Up to £125,000 Zero

The next £125,000 (the portion from £125,001 to £250,000) 2%

The next £675,000 (the portion from £250,001 to £925,000) 5%

The next £575,000 (the portion from £925,001 to £1.5 million) 10%

The remaining amount (the portion above £1.5 million) 12%

Example

In April 2025 you buy a house for £295,000. The SDLT you owe will be calculated as follows:

- 0% on the first £125,000 = £0
- 2% on the second £125,000 = £2,500
- 5% on the final £45,000 = £2,250
- total SDLT = £4,750
