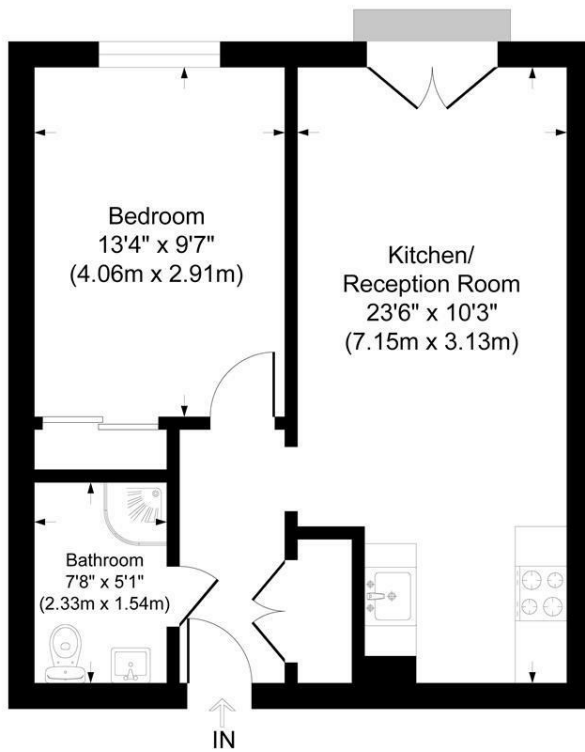
A well-presented one-bedroom first-floor flat set within a modern gated development in Central Walthamstow.
