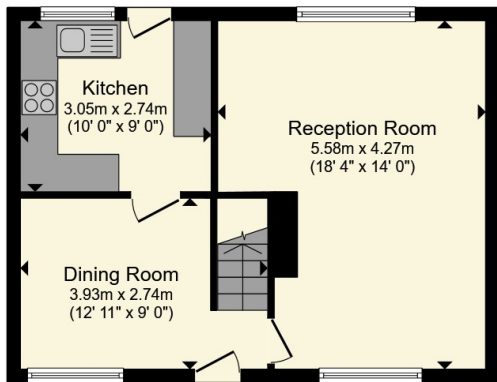

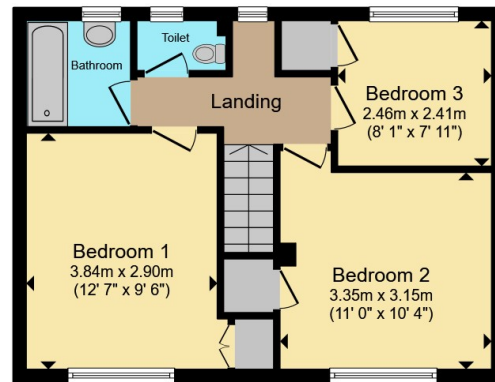

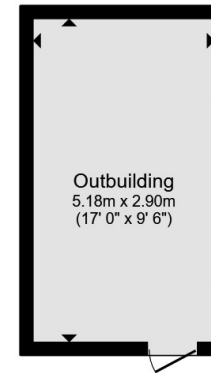




Ground Floor
