To the first floor, the property features three well-proportioned bedrooms and a family bathroom, providing comfortable accommodation for the whole household.

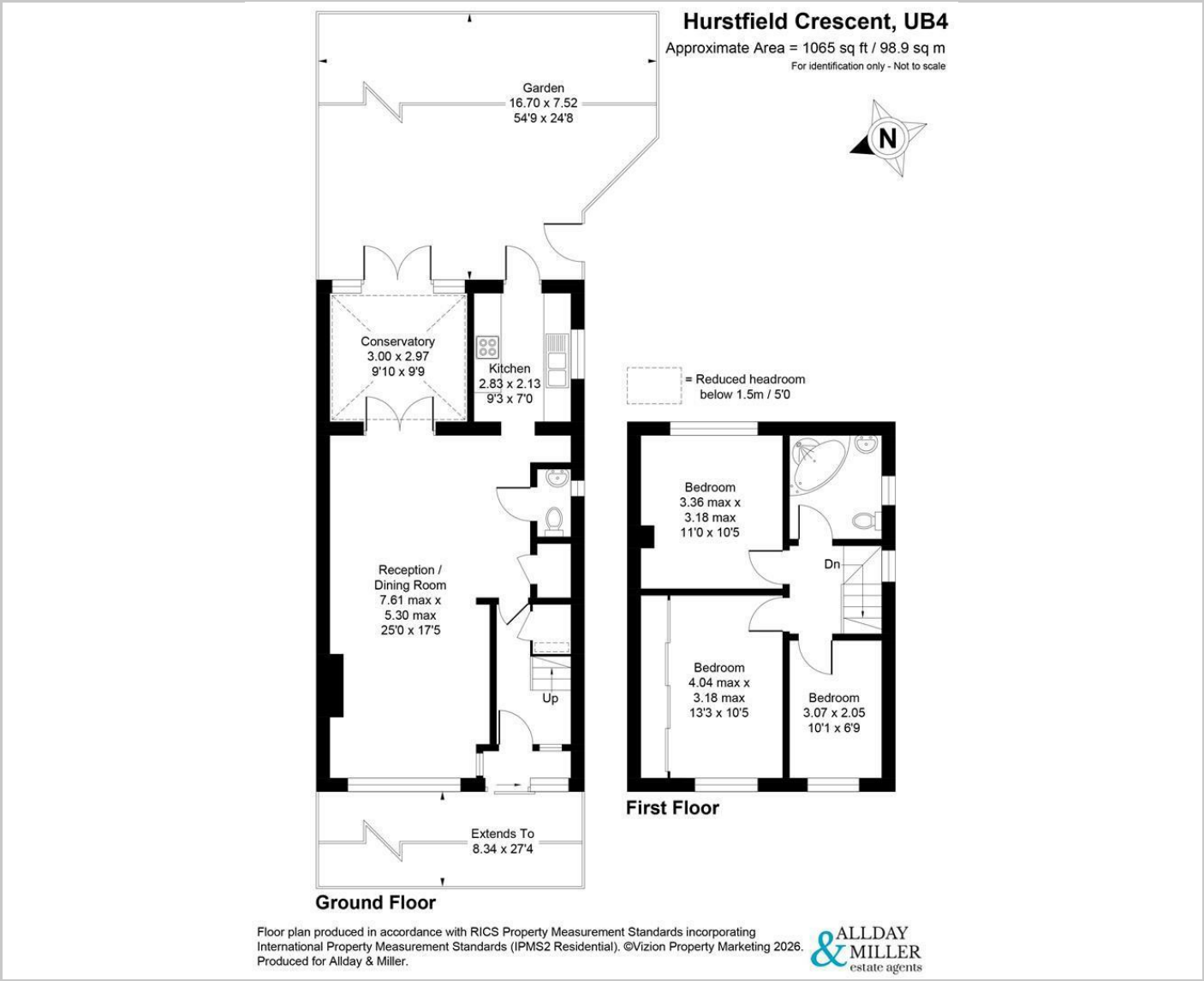

Situation

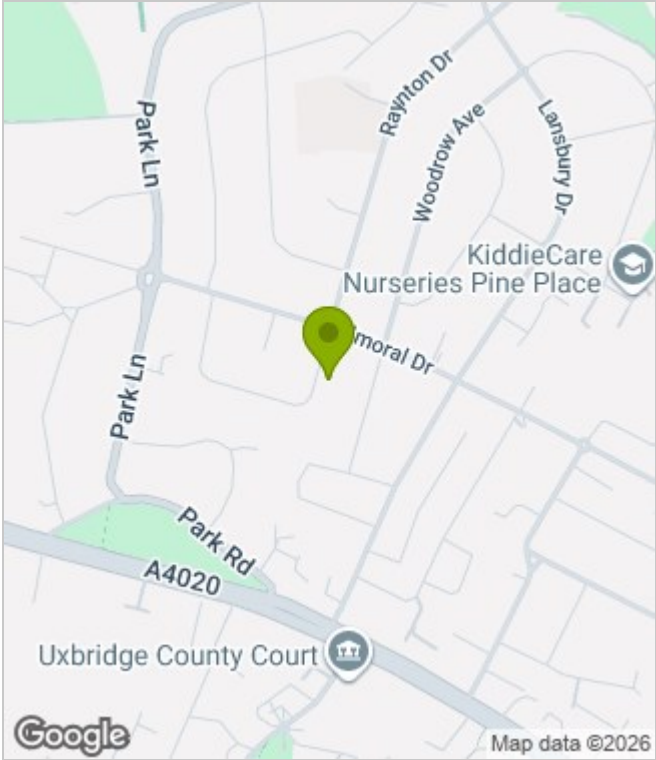

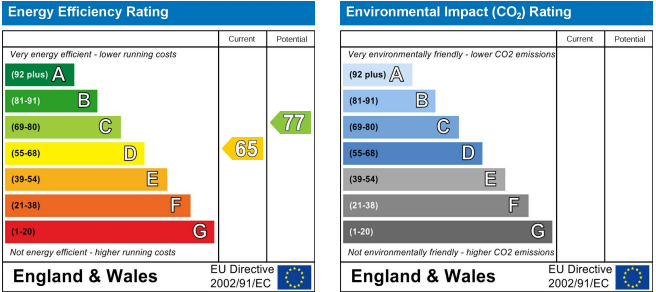
Floor Plans
