There are three good-sized bedrooms. One bedroom has a door providing access to the rear garden.

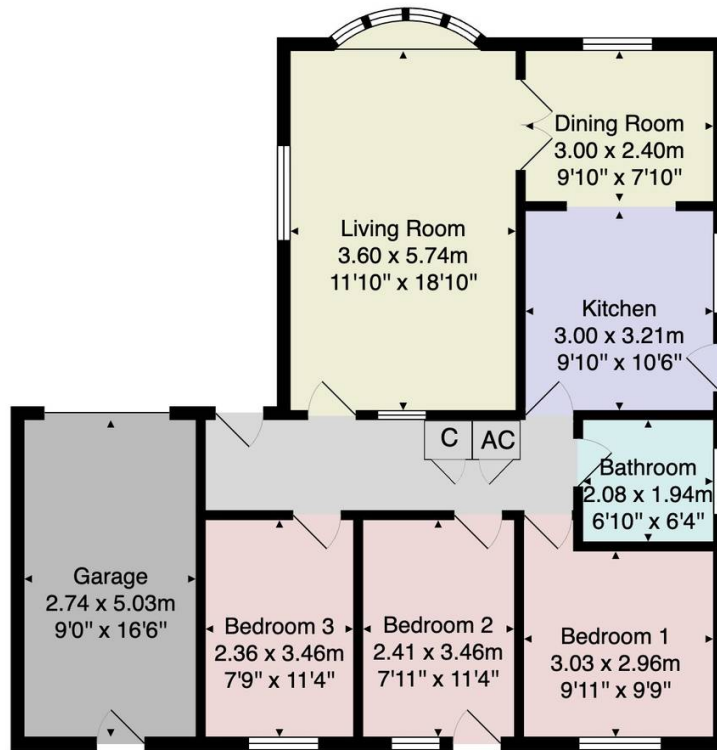
BATHROOM
