Upstairs, the property comprises three well-proportioned bedrooms. The principal bedroom is a generous double with two sash windows to the front, creating a bright and airy feel. Bedroom two is another comfortable double overlooking the garden, while bedroom three is a great-sized room, also enjoying a garden aspect.

Externally, the property boasts a beautiful, long rear garden, featuring a paved patio area adjoining the house, leading to a well-maintained lawn. A storage shed sits at the far end, providing useful outdoor storage.

Situated in a popular part of Crowborough, the home benefits from a perfect balance of peaceful surroundings and excellent connectivity. Jarvis Brook Station offers direct rail links to London, making it ideal for commuters.

The area is well served by highly regarded local schools within walking distance, along with a range of shops, cafés, and pubs.
