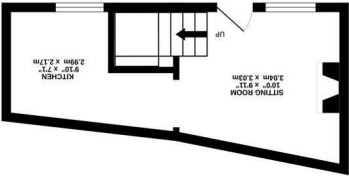
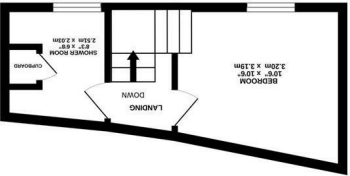

Ground floor

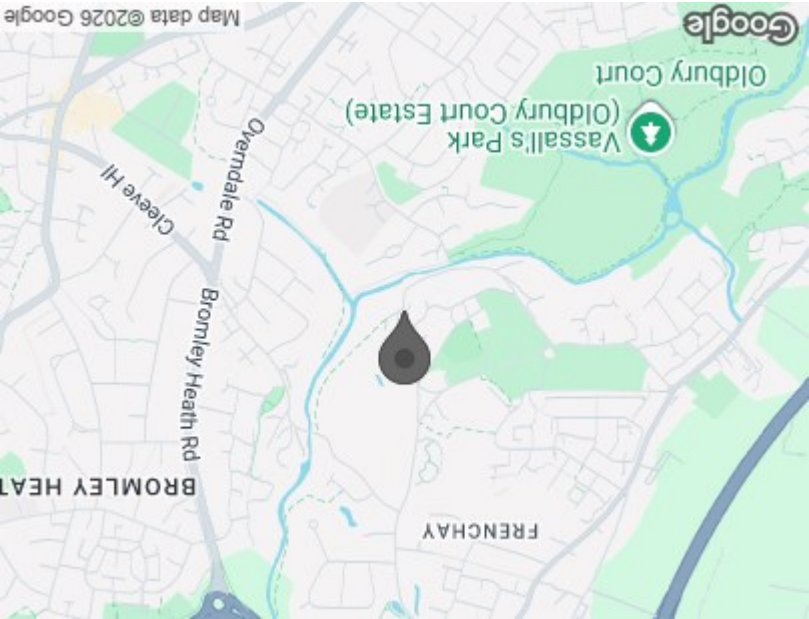

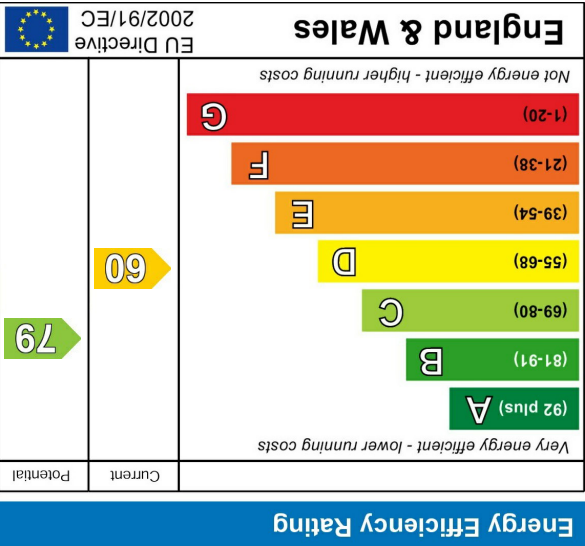
FLOOR PLAN
