About the property

A beautifully presented four bedroom period semi-detached family home situated on this highly desirable tree-lined avenue in East Sheen. Arranged over three floors this excellent property features an extended kitchen/dining/family room with full width glass doors opening onto 40' west facing garden and large 2nd floor principal bedroom suite.

The accommodation comprises; to the ground floor, entrance hall, W.C, elegant double reception room and kitchen/breakfast room. To the first floor are two double bedrooms and a single bedroom which is currently used as a study and a family bathroom. The second floor provides a wonderful principle bedroom suite.

Outside is an attractive landscaped west facing garden of approximately 40'.

East Sheen is a charming residential area located in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames. It is situated approximately 8 miles southwest of central London and is bordered by the River Thames to the north and Richmond Park to the west.

One of the main attractions of East Sheen is its proximity to Richmond Park, which covers an area of over 2,300 acres and is the largest of the Royal Parks in London. The park offers a range of recreational activities, including walking, cycling, horse riding, and wildlife watching. It is also home to several historic buildings, including Pembroke Lodge, a former royal residence that now houses a popular cafe and event venue.

In addition to Richmond Park, East Sheen has several other green spaces, including Palewell Common and Sheen Common, both of which offer opportunities for outdoor activities and relaxation.

East Sheen has a thriving high street, which is home to a range of shops, cafes, restaurants, and pubs. There are also several supermarkets, including Waitrose and Tesco, making it easy for residents to do their weekly shopping.

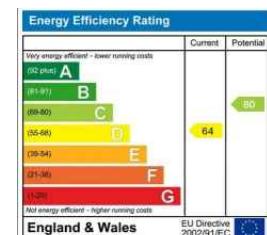
