About The Property

A beautiful townhouse situated in Kingsbury Square, Wilton, offering spacious accommodation.

The property comprises a large entrance hall. Following this, there is a formal lounge that could serve as a dining room, benefiting from a working open fireplace. On the other side of the front of the ground floor, there is a large second reception room with a central feature fireplace, which has a door leading into the kitchen and dining area.

Upstairs, there are a total of five bedrooms. The primary bedroom benefits from dual-aspect windows and ample wardrobes, with a secondary door leading into the second bedroom, making the space adaptable as either a bedroom or dressing room. Four of the five bedrooms can accommodate a small double bed,

while the fifth bedroom is suited for a single bed or can serve as a well-proportioned home office. There are two separate bathrooms on the first floor; the first bathroom features a large corner shower, and the second features a full-size bathtub.

Outside, the garden is divided into two sections. The first area is laid with artificial lawn, complemented by hedging and small borders surrounding it. The other main garden area is gravelled and provides access to the garage door located at the side of the barn storage space.

The barn is currently used for storage but could be converted into a large garage or repurposed for another use. The property benefits from off-street parking, accessed through double manual wooden gates. The current layout restricts this to parking for one car, but it can be modified to allow for additional parking if desired.

The property is offered unfurnished on a long-term basis.



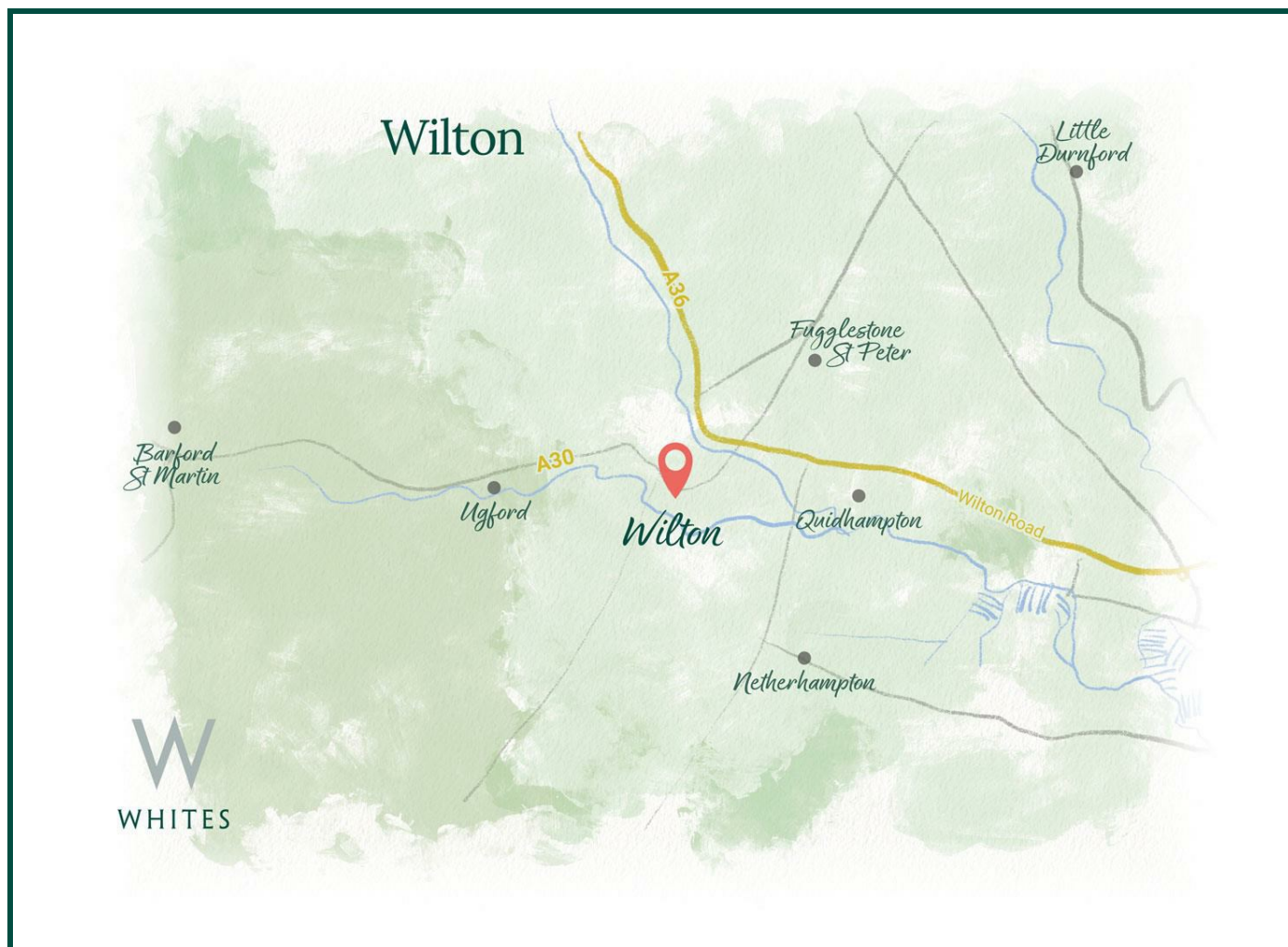


Location

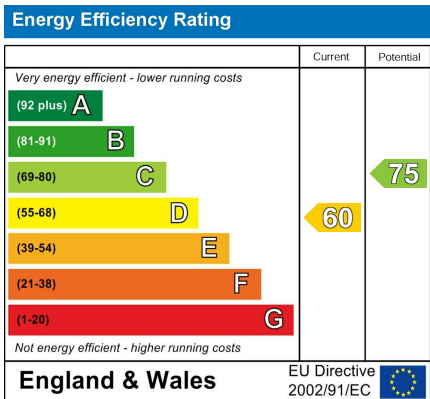

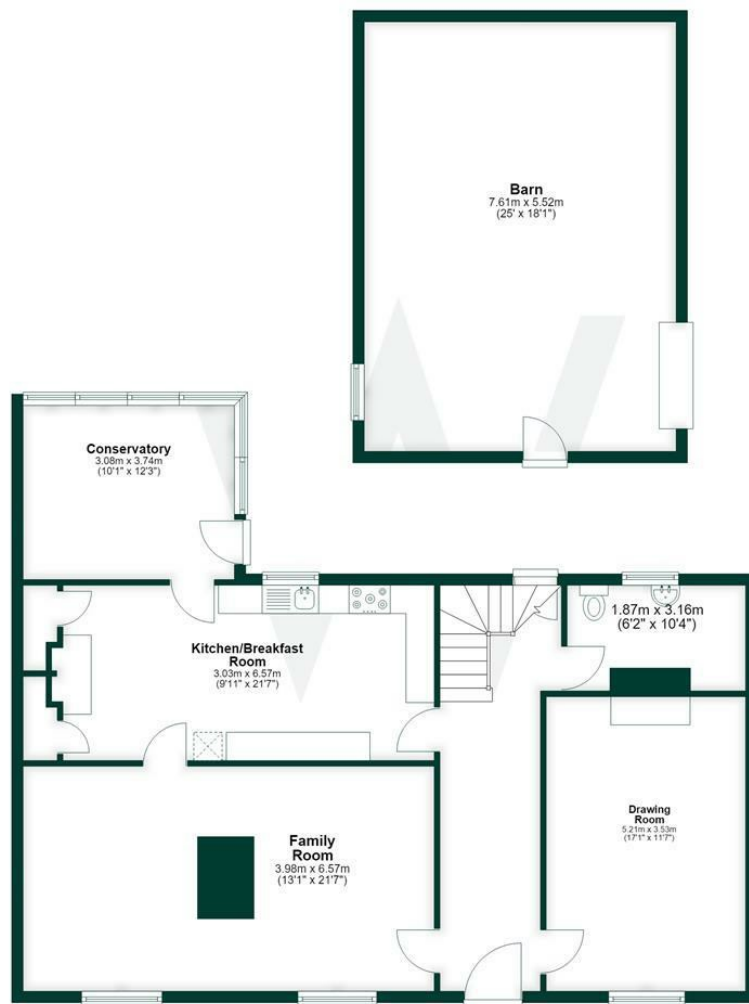
