A very well presented two double bedroom semi detached home in the popular village of Horrabridge, with enclosed garden and outbuilding.

Sitting in an elevated position with views across the nearby fields, a gated path leads from the road up to the property. The front garden is gravelled for low maintenance and a couple of steps lead up to the front door.

The entrance hall is bright with plenty of natural light flooding in. Stairs lead to the first floor and there is a large cupboard housing the boiler as well as under stairs storage. The front room is spacious and benefits from a large window, catching the countryside views.

Pocket sliding doors open into the open plan kitchen/diner, perfect for entertaining or family dining. The modern kitchen has a range of wall and base units, housing a built in electric oven and microwave oven, integrated dishwasher and electric hob and incorporates a handy breakfast bar.

Upstairs, there are two large double bedrooms, the master with built in wardrobes and a cupboard.

The bathroom boasts a modern suite with bath and shower over, low level WC and basin all with modern gold finishes.

The landing benefits from multiple cupboards for storage.

Outside to the rear is a low maintenance enclosed garden with artificial turf, and a raised deck to the rear to make the most of the sunny summer days. At the rear of the garden is a stone shed with light, electricity and plumbing for a washing machine.

Floor Plan




