To the rear of the property is a generous kitchen and breakfast room, providing ample space for cooking, dining, and entertaining while overlooking the garden.

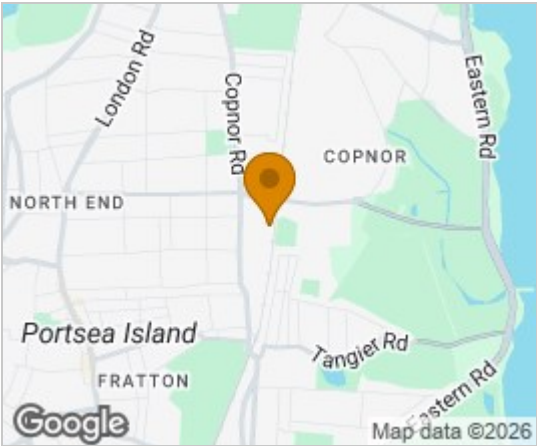

Situated in a great location within walking distance of local amenities and well-regarded schools, this fantastic home also benefits from being offered to the market with no onward chain.

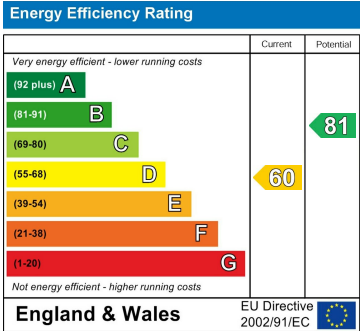
Area Map
