Conveniently located for local amenities, schooling, and transport links into Norwich city centre, this home represents an excellent opportunity to acquire a property in a well established and sought-after area.

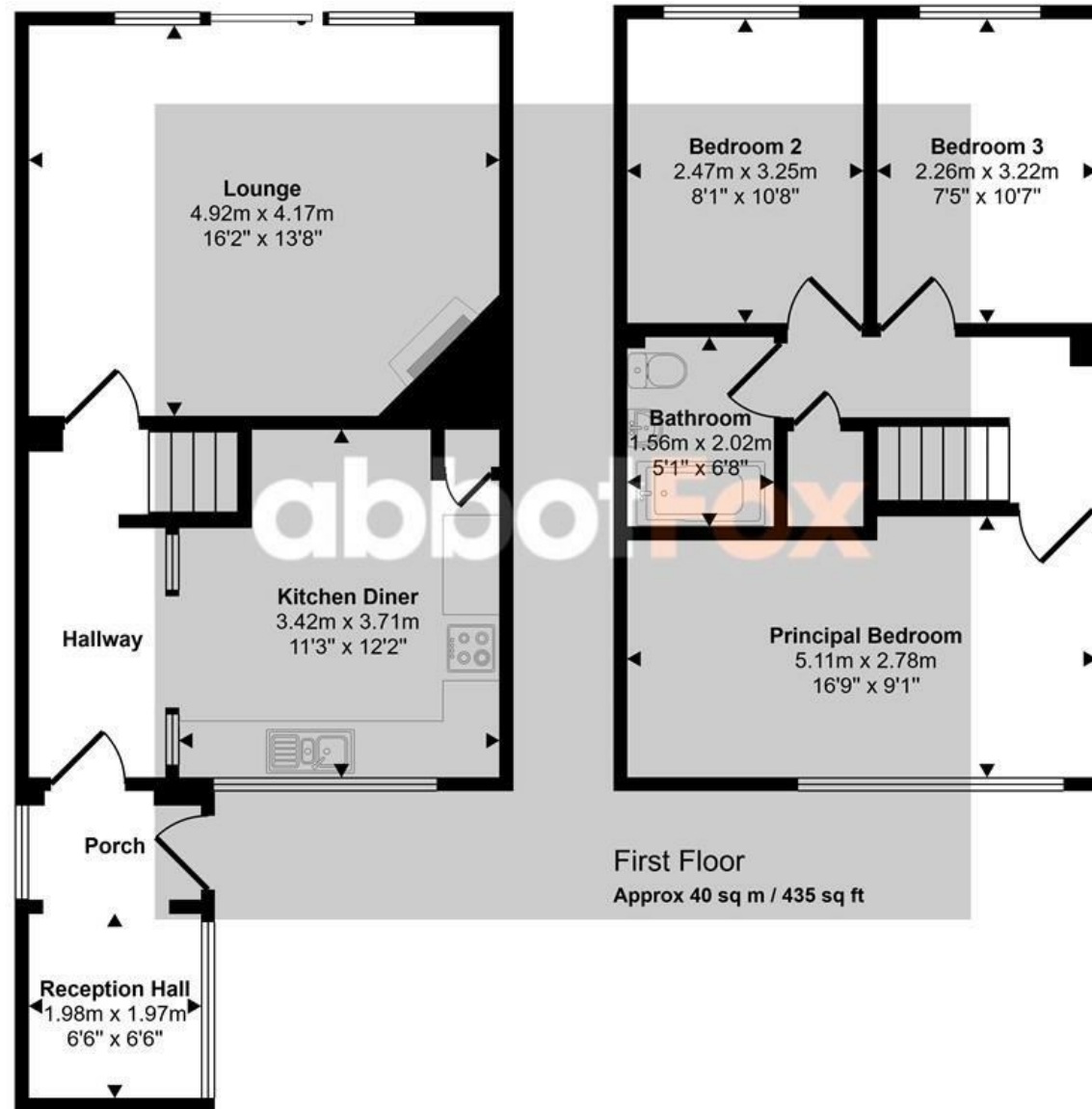
