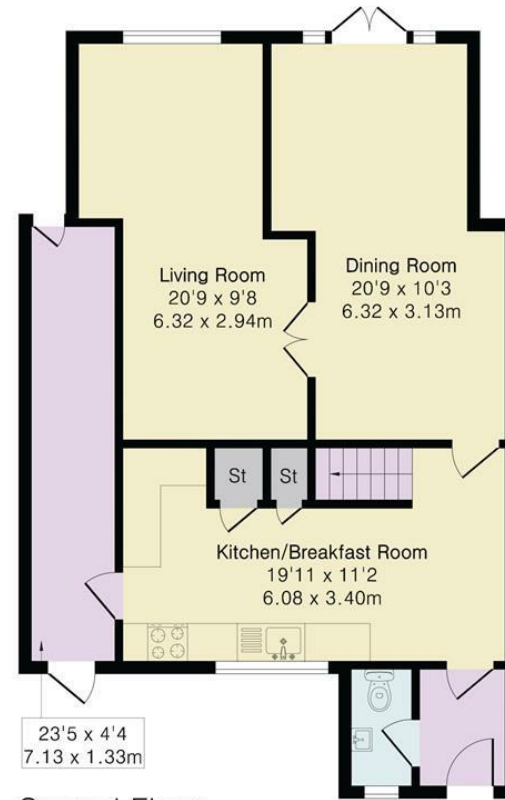




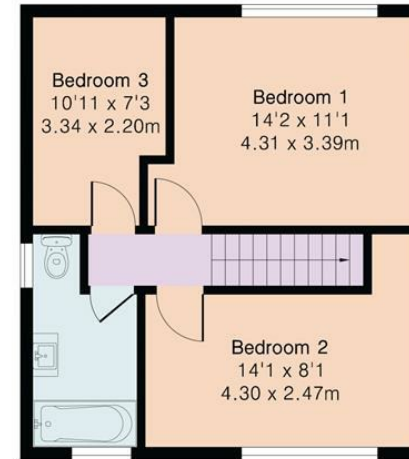

First Floor



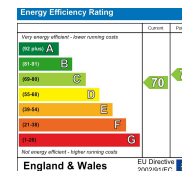
