Bedroom One

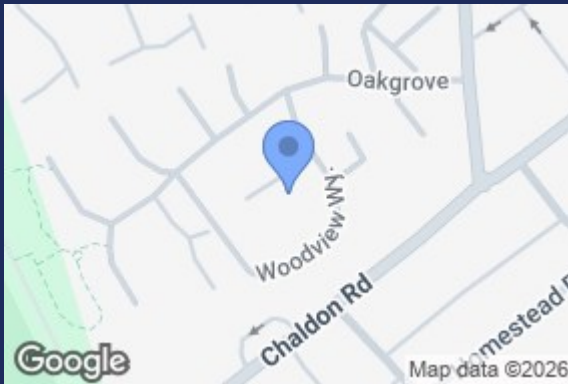
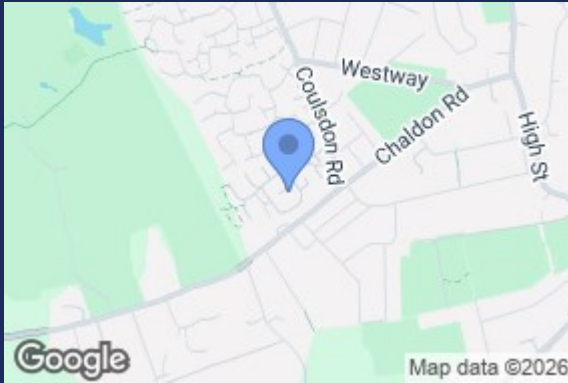
Bedroom one includes fitted wardrobe, radiator and double-glazed two-casement window.

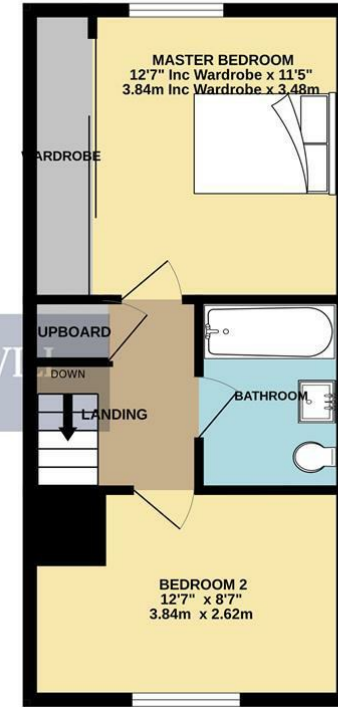
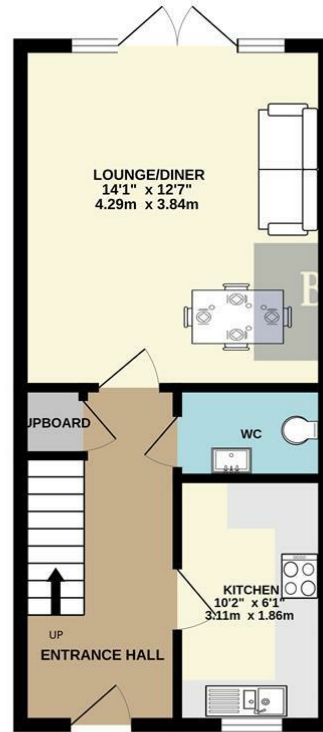
Rear Garden
