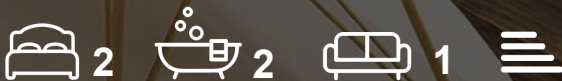

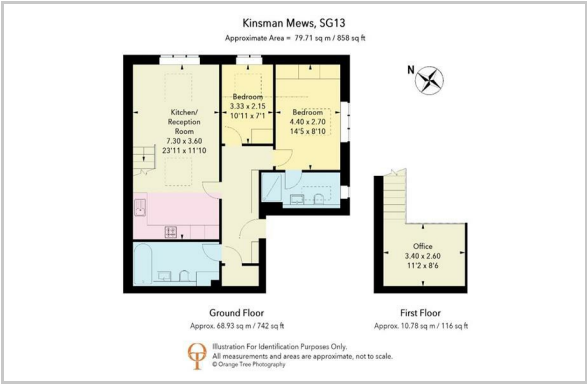

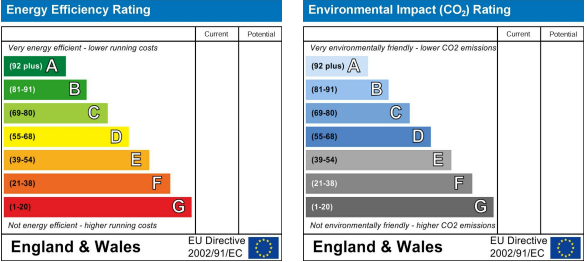
Area Map
