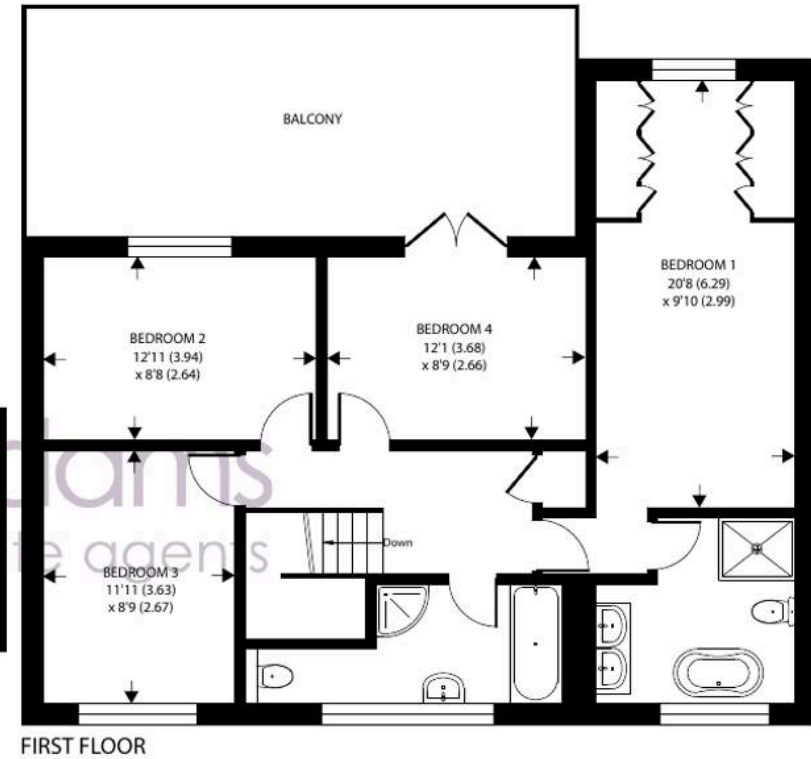
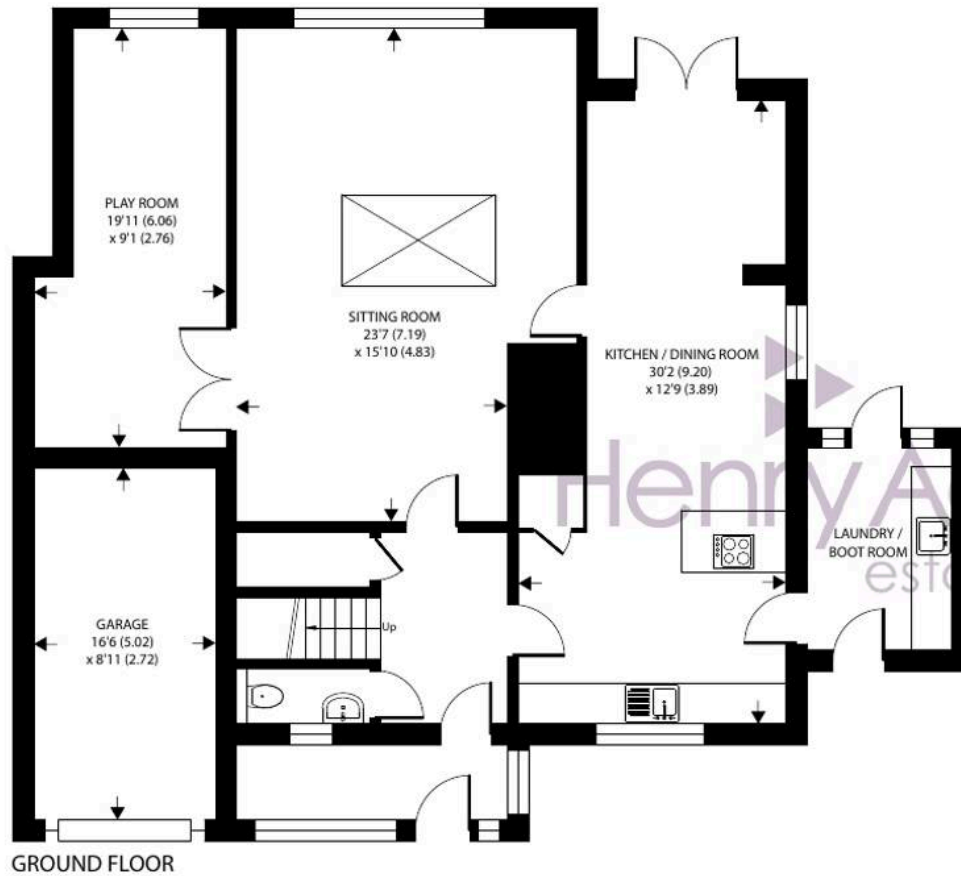

Location – The historic medieval town of Arundel includes a range of independent and high street shops, restaurants, recreational facilities and mainline railway station to London Victoria (1hr 20min approx). The cathedral city of Chichester is approximately 10 miles west of Arundel and offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars and festival theatre. Goodwood is located to the west and is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are excellent sailing facilities around Littlehampton and Chichester Harbour with also a range water sports from the beaches at Littlehampton and West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.

Directions – From Chichester, proceed east on the A27. At the Fontwell roundabout, follow the signs to Arundel. When you come to the large roundabout at Arundel, turn right, signposted Ford and Climping. Take the first turning on the right into Torton Hill Road which then leads into Dalloway Road. Number 9 is on the left after Stewards Rise.
