Tucked away in one of Heacham's most desirable and rarely available locations, 74 Hunstanton Road is a beautifully crafted barn conversion that effortlessly blends period character with modern convenience. Completed in 2015 to an exceptional standard, the property sits next to Heacham Manor Golf Club, offering a peaceful setting with easy access to the village, the coastline and everything that makes this part of North Norfolk so appealing.

From the moment you step inside, there is a sense of quality and craftsmanship throughout. The ground floor has been designed around open-plan living, creating a sociable and welcoming space that works equally well for everyday life and entertaining. At its heart is a bespoke kitchen fitted with stone worktops and a practical built-in pantry, providing both style and functionality. The kitchen flows naturally into the dining and sitting areas, where character features including exposed brick and chalk walls sit comfortably alongside contemporary finishes.

Oak flooring runs throughout the principal ground floor living spaces and underfloor heating ensures year-round comfort, while timber double-glazed windows complement the property's barn heritage and help create a warm and inviting atmosphere.

A useful utility area, finished with tiled flooring, provides valuable additional storage and keeps the practicalities of daily life neatly tucked away. Upstairs, there are three well-proportioned bedrooms and a family bathroom, offering comfortable accommodation for both permanent living and coastal getaways.

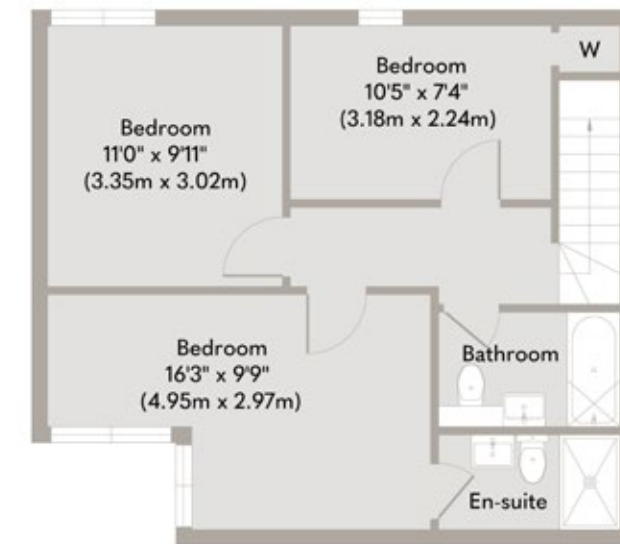


Outside there is a courtyard garden that is west facing which is bursting with colourful flowers and makes for an ideal spot to relax in the evening sun.

The character of the original building remains a defining feature, with exposed ceiling timbers and carefully retained architectural details providing a constant reminder of the property's heritage. Yet the overall feel is one of a home designed for modern living, with thoughtful improvements and high-quality fixtures and fittings throughout.

With two allocated parking spaces and a setting that places golf, countryside walks, village amenities and the North Norfolk coast all within easy reach, this is a home that offers a lifestyle as attractive as the property itself. A regular bus service stops outside the property, with buses running approximately every 15 minutes, providing convenient connections along the coast and to nearby towns.
