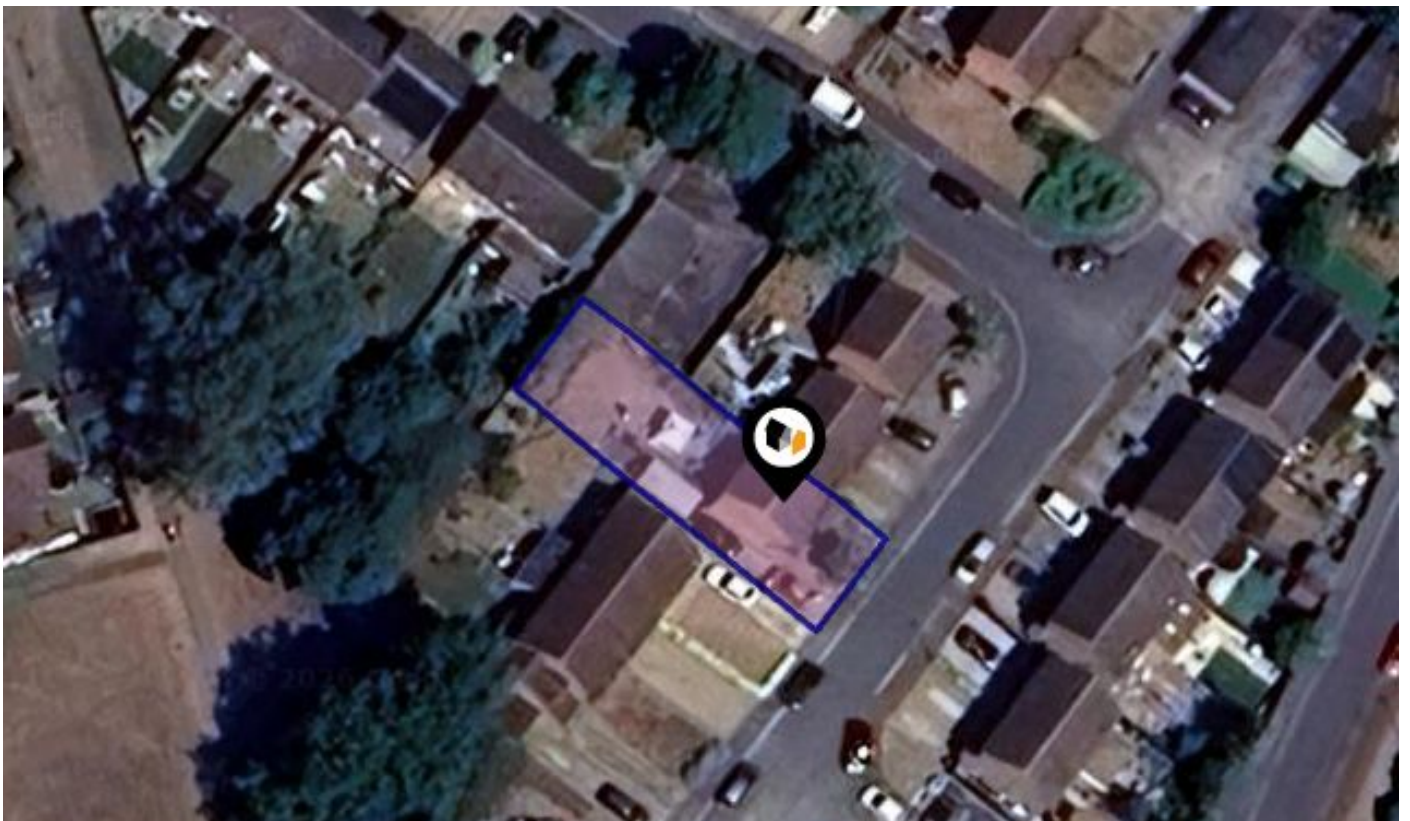

The kitchen was re-fitted approximately five years ago and provides modern, practical space for cooking and storage. A useful study adds flexibility, perfect for home working or as a playroom.

Upstairs, there are three well-proportioned bedrooms served by a modern family bathroom. The bathroom, along with the flooring, windows, doors and boiler, were all updated around five years ago, ensuring the home is ready to move into and easy to maintain.

Externally, the standout feature is the unusually large rear garden, offering excellent outdoor space with potential for further landscaping or extension (subject to the usual consents). The property also benefits from a garage and off-road parking.

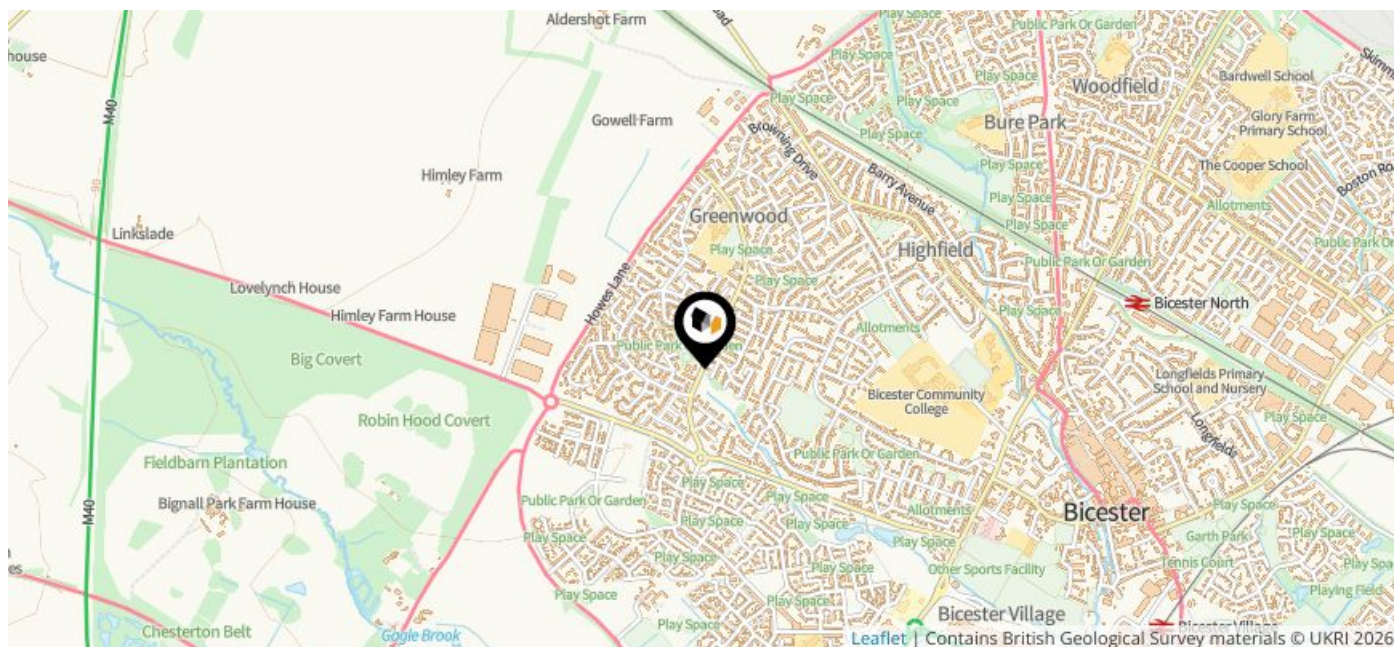

The Coal Authority has records of over 175,000 mine entries within the UK captured in the National Coal Mining database, derived from sources including abandonment plans, geological and topographical plans.

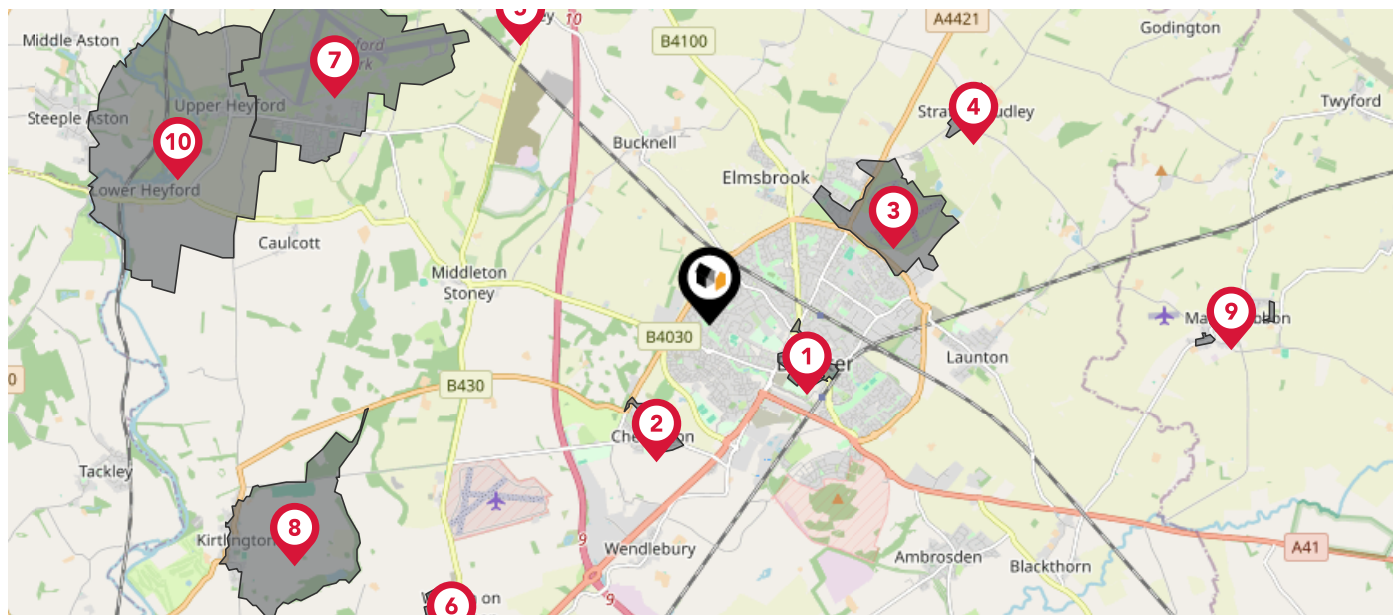

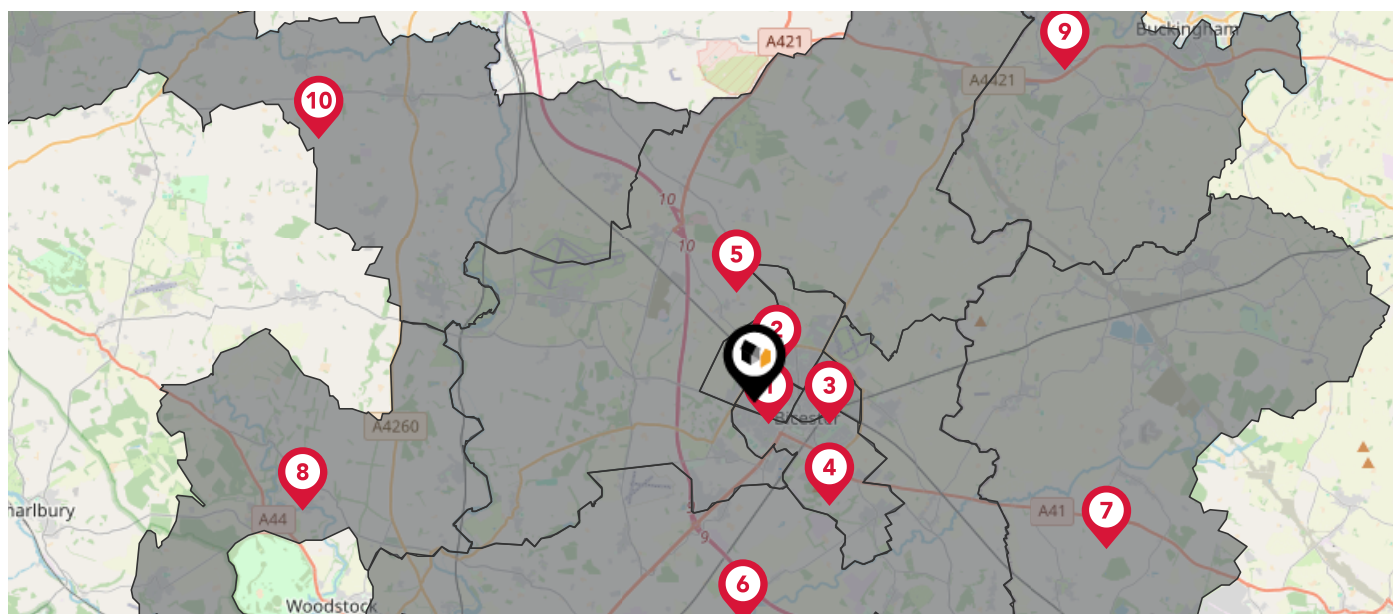

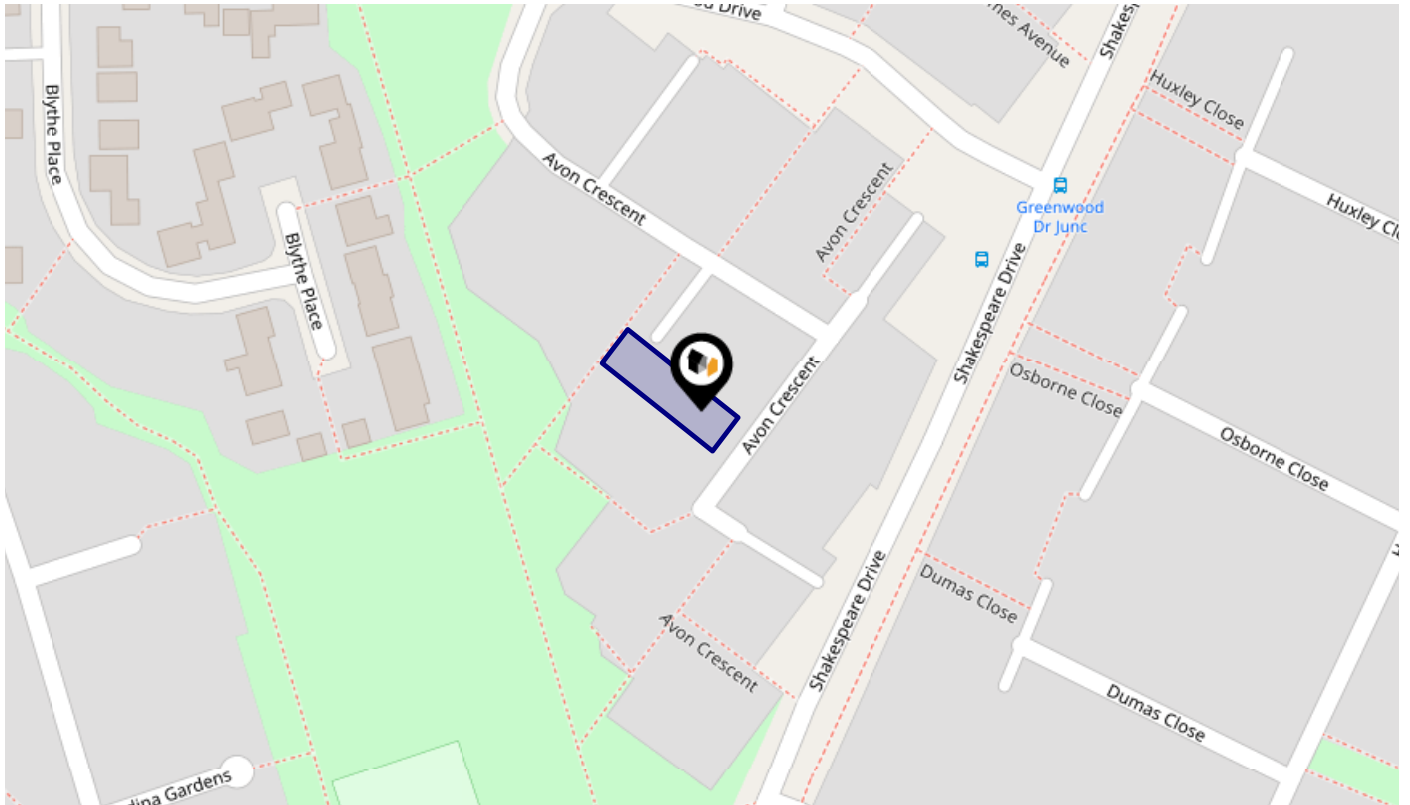

Rail Noise Data

This data indicates the level of noise according to the strategic noise mapping of rail sources within areas with a population of at least 100,000 people (agglomerations) and along Network Rail and HS1 traffic routes.

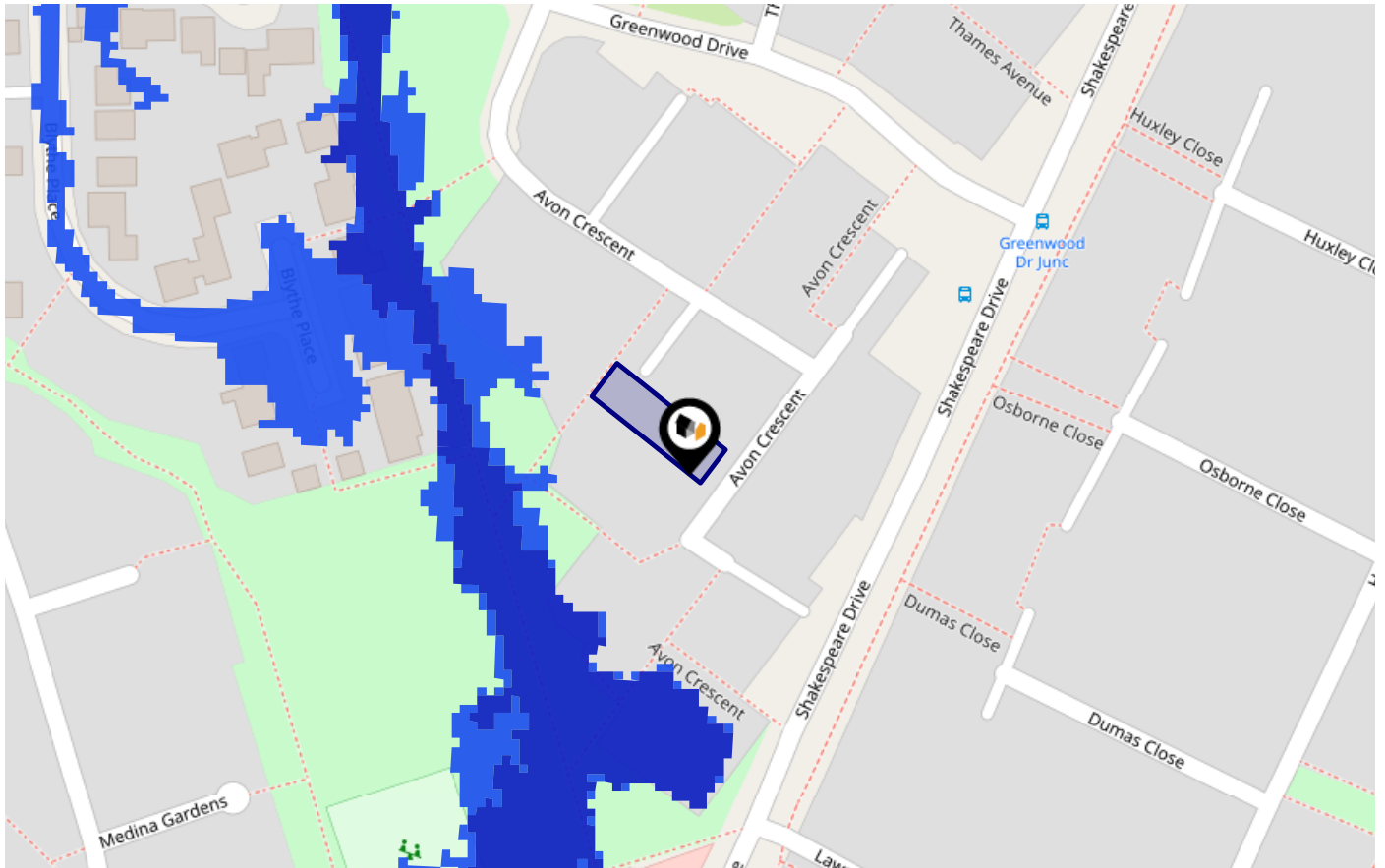

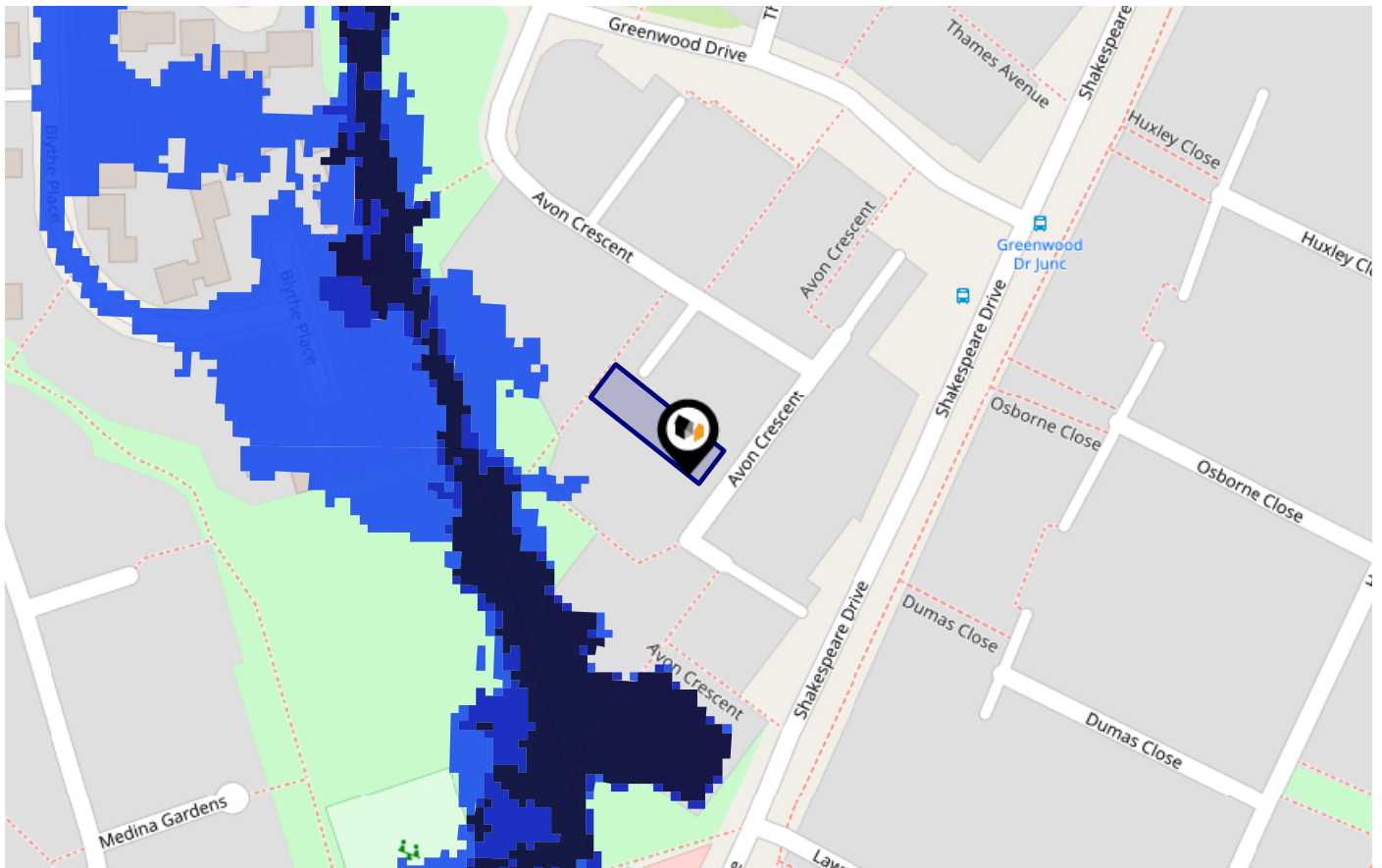

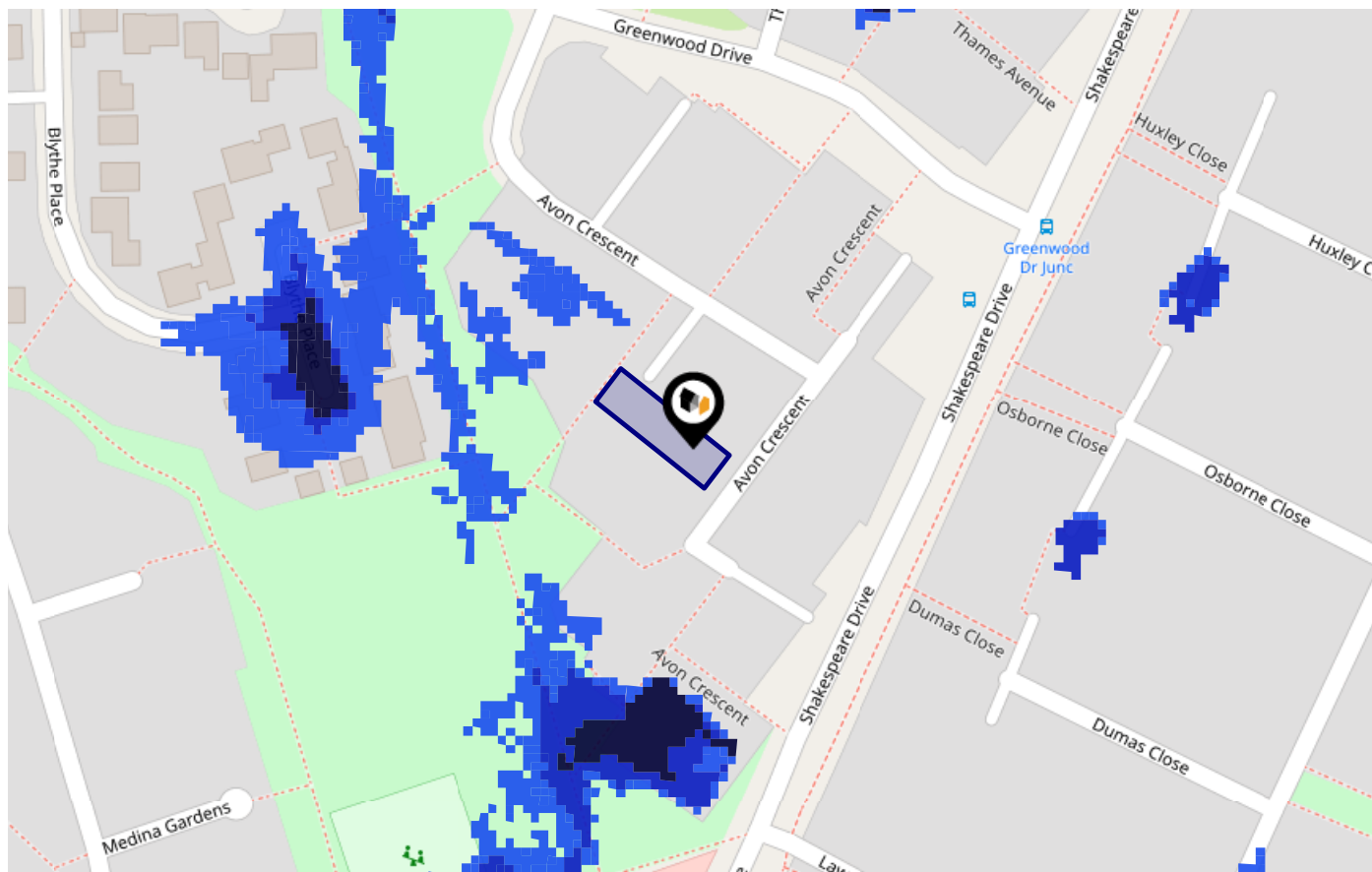

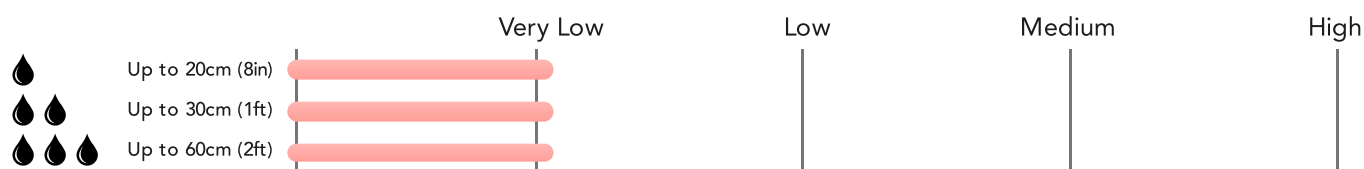

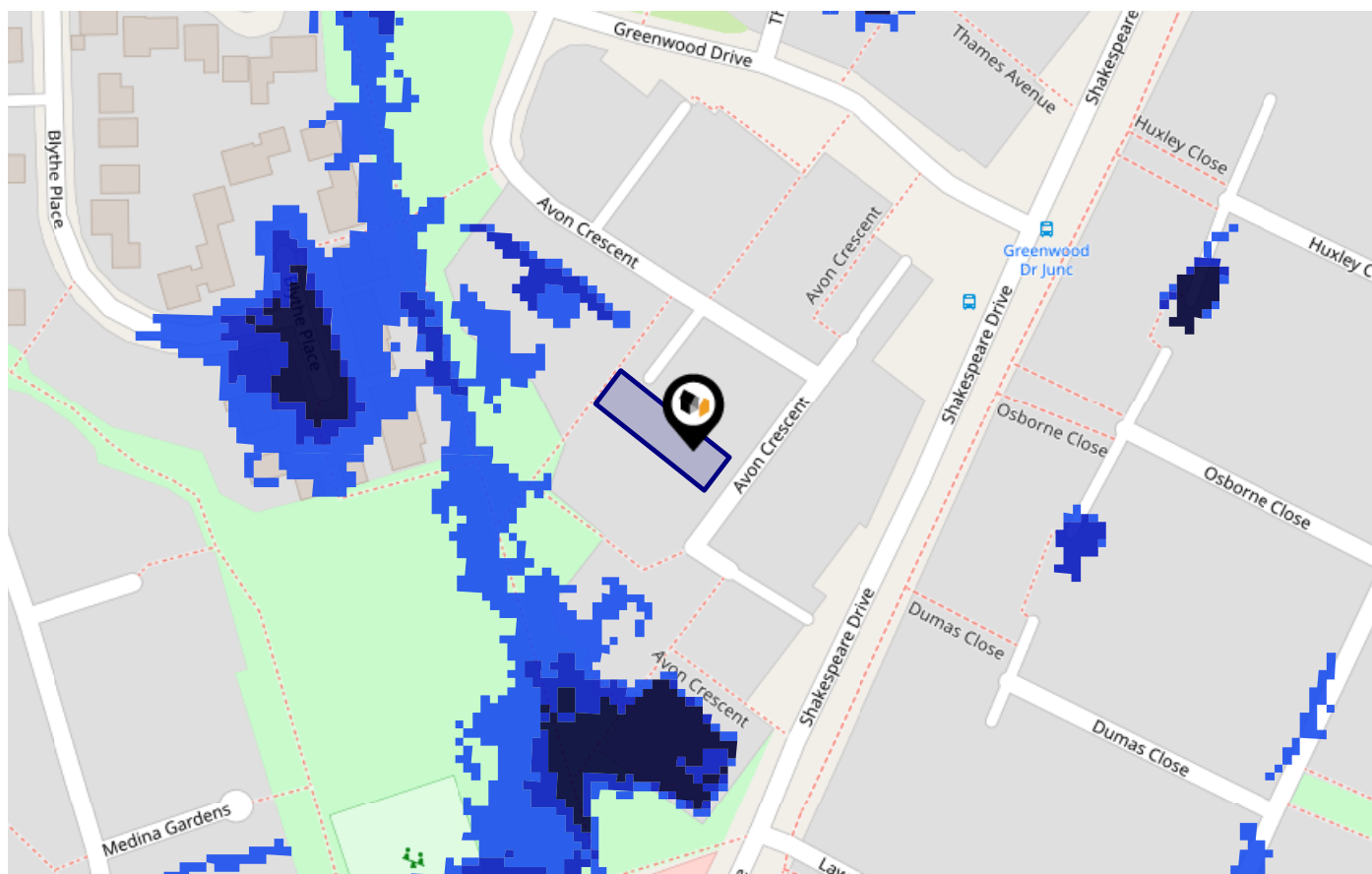

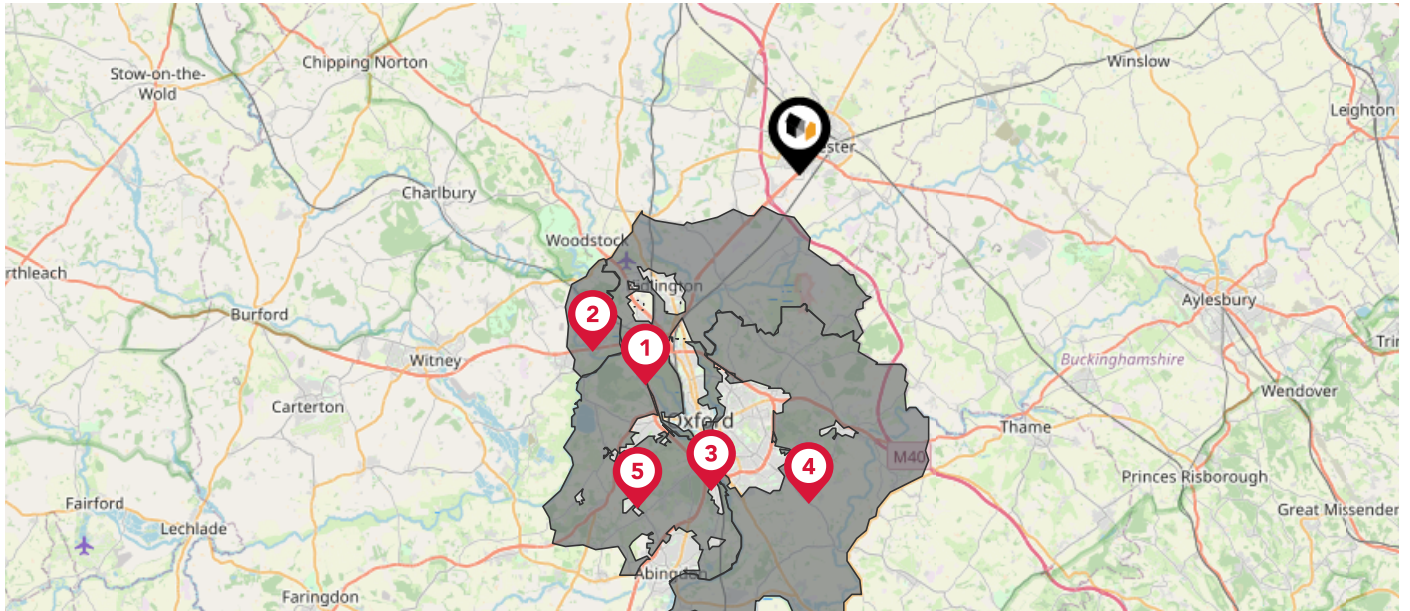

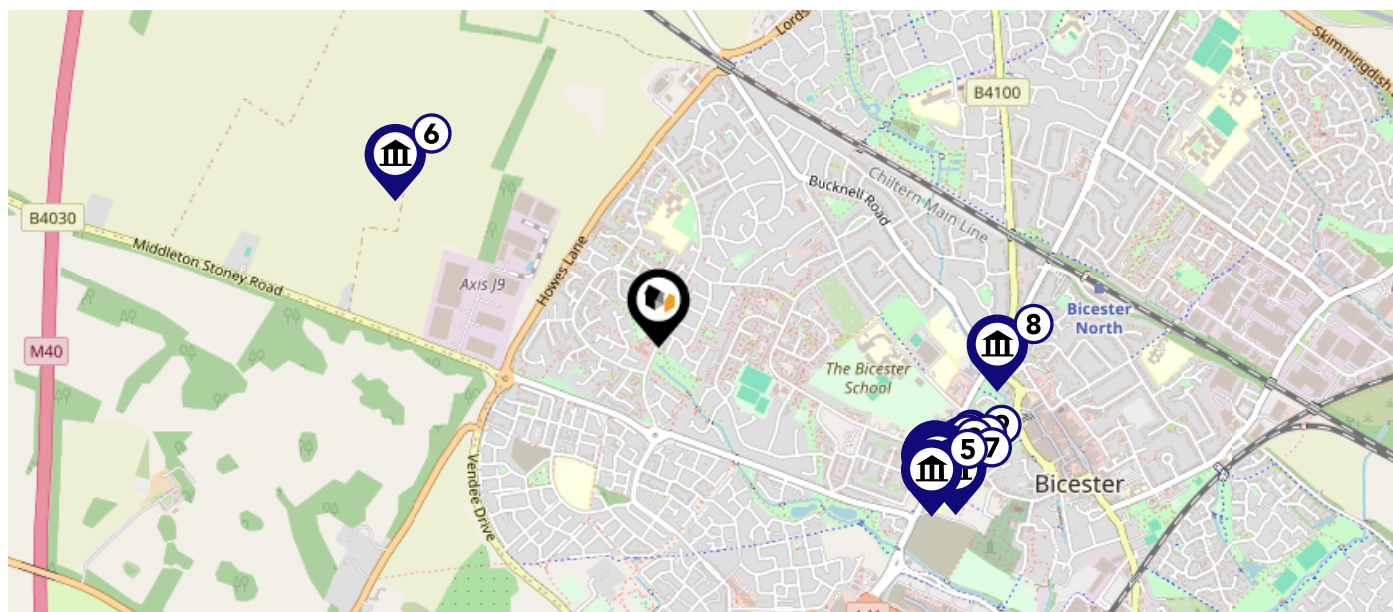

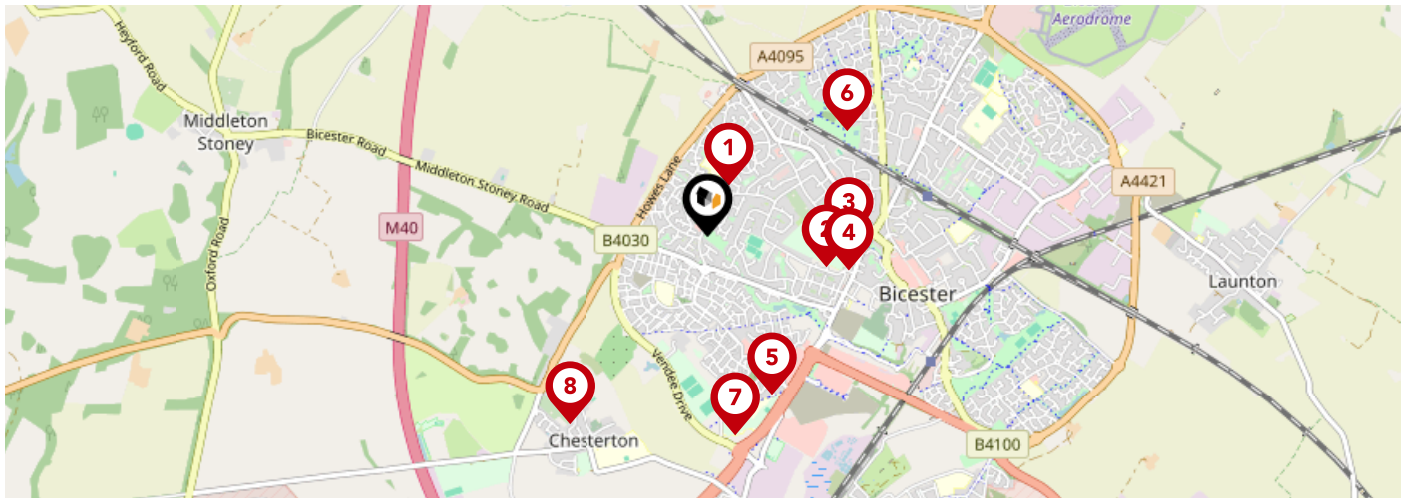

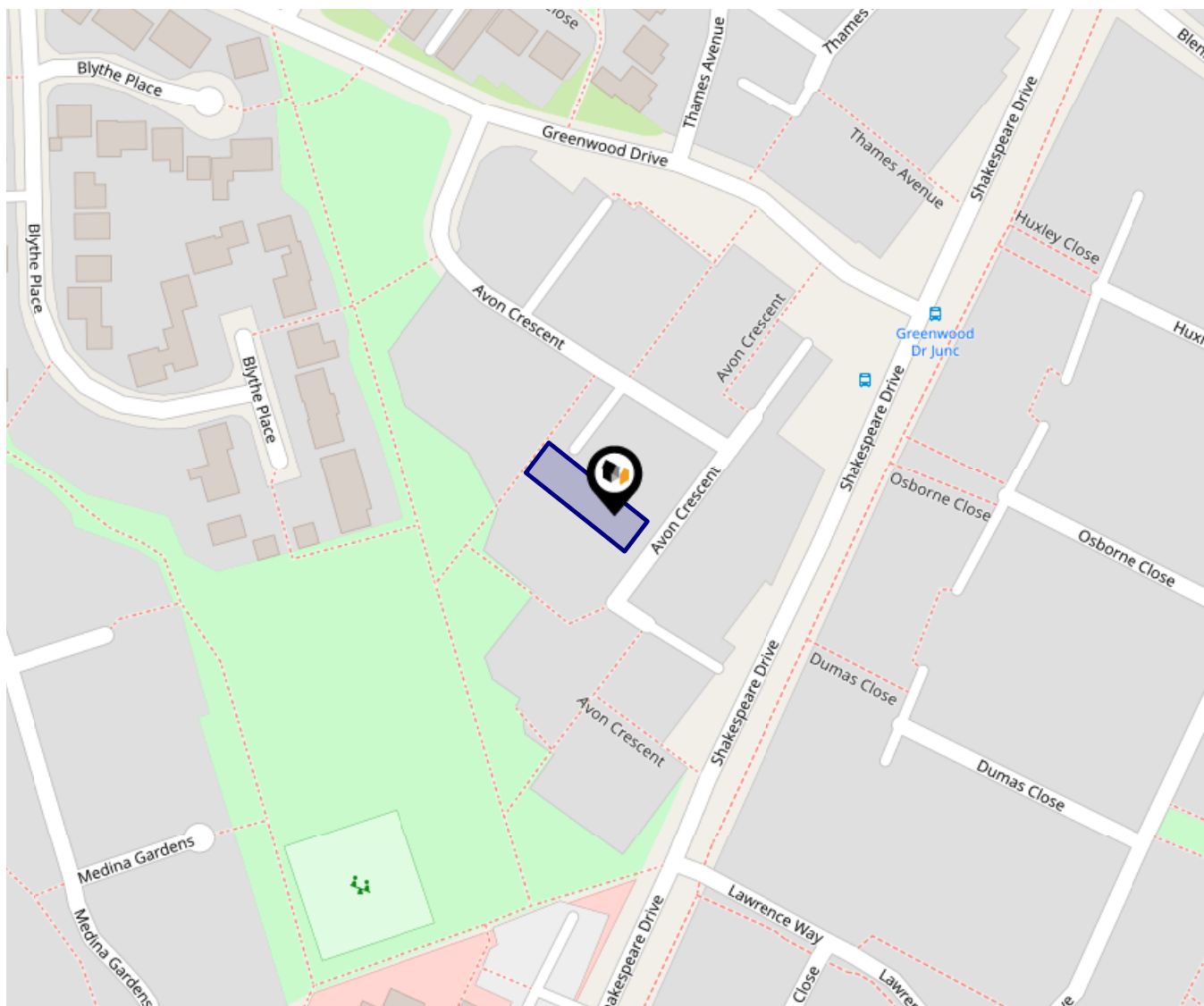


What is Radon?

Radon is a natural radioactive gas, which enters buildings from the ground. Exposure to high concentrations increases the risk of lung cancer. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) recommends that radon levels should be reduced in homes where the annual average is at or above 200 becquerels per cubic metre (200 Bq/m3).



Local Area Road Noise



This data indicates the level of noise according to the strategic noise mapping of road sources within areas with a population of at least 100,000 people (agglomerations) and along major traffic routes. This indicates a 24 hour annual average noise level with separate weightings for the evening and night periods.

Noise levels are modelled on a 10m grid at a receptor height of 4m above ground, polygons are then produced by merging neighbouring cells within the following noise classes:

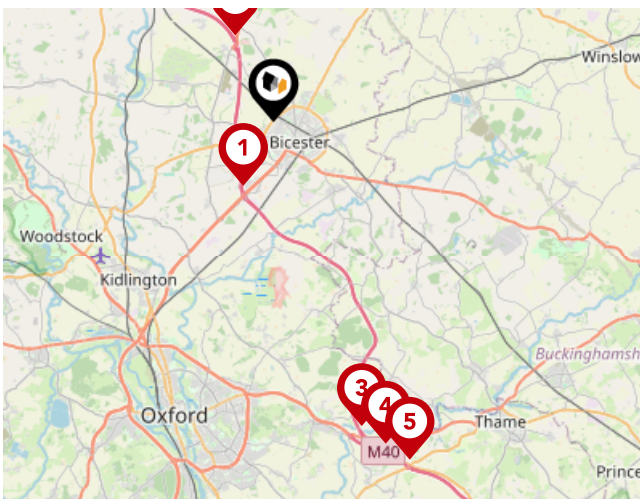

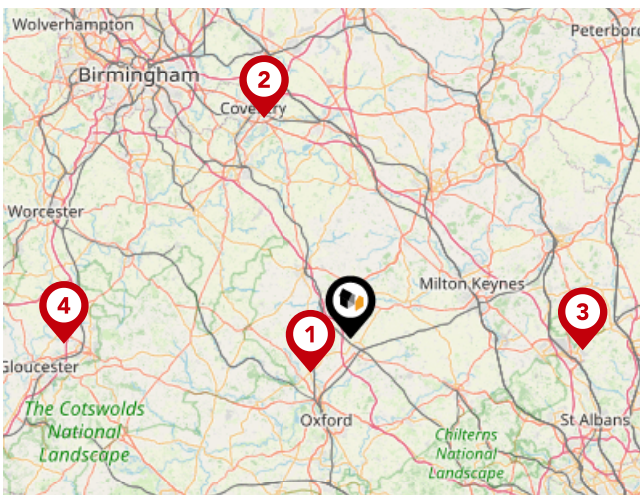

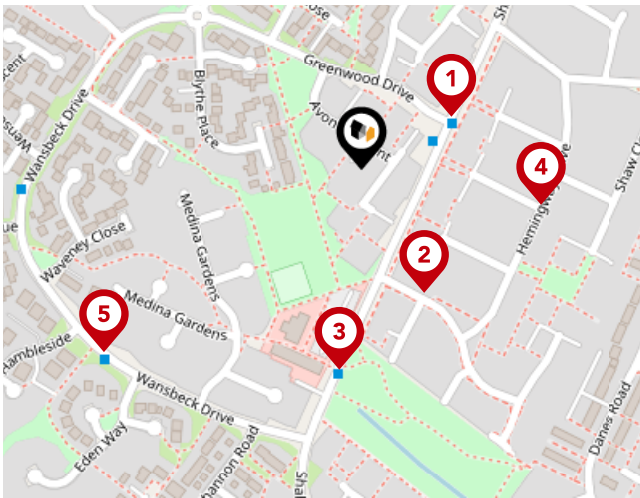
