Bathroom

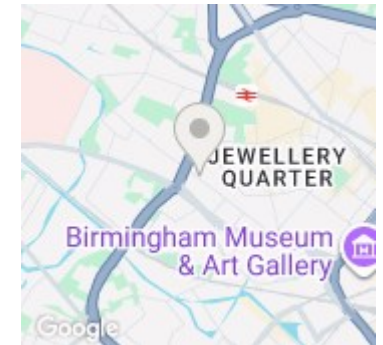
The bathroom is finished to a high standard with floor-to-ceiling stone-effect gray tiling. It includes:
