The cottage is notable for its traditional architecture, featuring a classic brick façade lending it an enchanting and timeless appeal.

There is an additional second room perfectly suited for a guest bedroom, walk in dressing area or even a home office or study space, with views from the window looking out onto the open countryside beyond.

Lastly there is a convenient bathroom with a contemporary three piece suite, vanity mirror and in built storage.





This garden is a spacious, generous sized (over 120 foot) outdoor area with a mix of open space and mature greenery, perfect for a variety of uses and accessed just a few steps from the cottage.

The garden is mostly flat and is bordered by wooden fencing, providing privacy and a sense of enclosure. The ground is a combination of bare earth, lawn and pebbled paths, with patches of grass and scattered plants adding a natural touch as well as a paved patio seating space to enjoy.

At the foot of the garden is a shaded space covered by mature trees with dense foliage, creating a canopy that filters sunlight and provides a cool, refreshing atmosphere.

The ground is covered with small pebbles, giving the garden a rustic, natural feel. Additionally there is a detached outbuilding with power and light connections, which could be used for working from home or to offer scope for a full conversion if required.

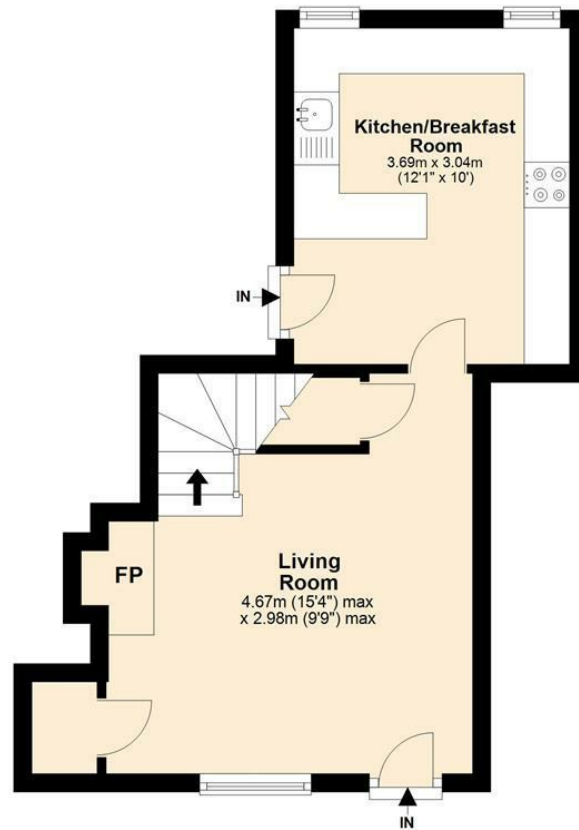

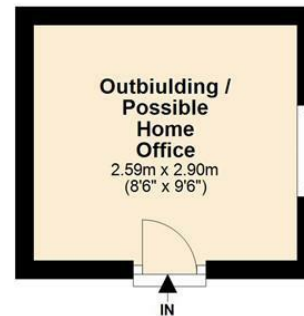


Floor Plan
