This well presented accommodation comprises of an entrance porch leading to a spacious reception hallway, which is a particular feature of a Gleeson built home. Outside to the front is a deep block paved driveway providing ample off street parking and leading to the garage.

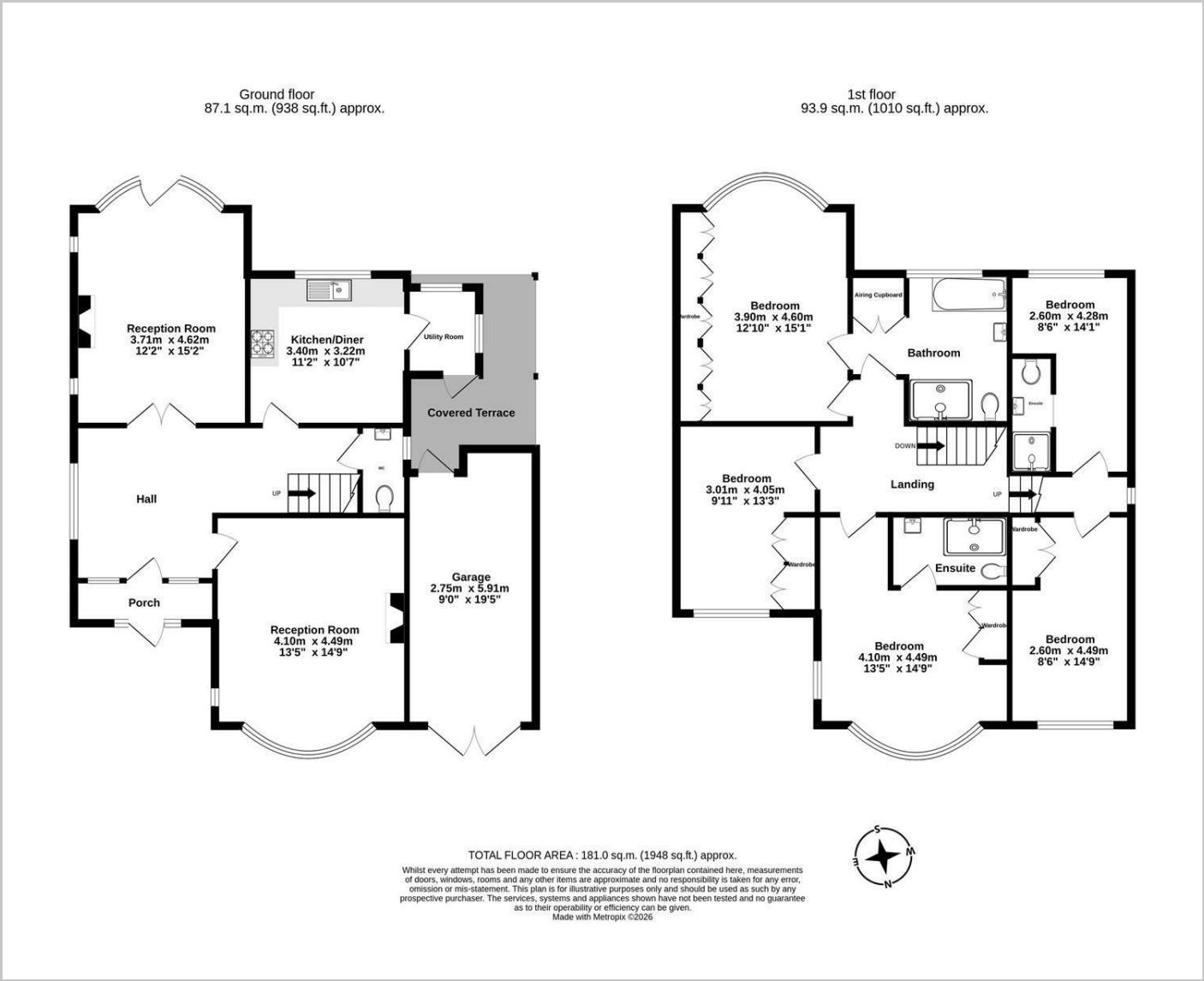
The mature rear south east facing garden predominantly laid to lawn.

Viewing is highly recommended.

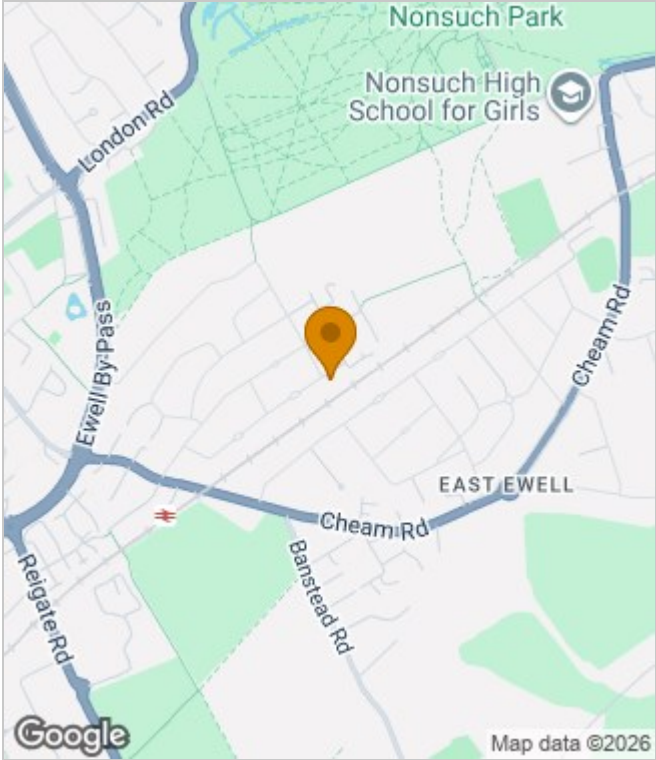

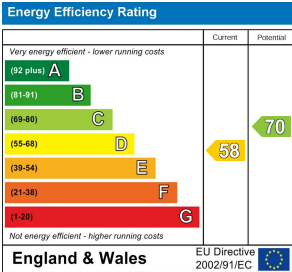
Floor Plans
